Amended Rules and Regulations to Conform to Order
of ERC dated October 30, 1980 in Case No. 7768

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Domestic customers shall make application for service at office of company, giving name of applicant, mailing address and location of home to be served, type of heating used, size piping to appliance. Where open heaters and floor furnances are they must be vented to outside.

Commercial customers shall, give kind of business, size of space to be heated and other use of gas in premises. Type of heating equipment, MCF recommended by manufacturer for same, pressure needed, for all purpose use. Size of piping to inside of building.

(1) Customer: meter shall be installed at nearest point on company's main or service line, not to exceed 100 feet.

(2) Company to furnish meter, regulator, stop and fittings to customer down side.

~~(3) Fee of \$50.00 - to tap line and install meter and regulator on initial service. Customer to be charged for all connections on his side. Item (3) is hereby deleted, per Order 10-30-80, in Case No. 7768.~~

(4) Customer to install not less than 1" service line, approved piping to inside appliances, without reduction in size except same may be reduced at floor level to size opening of appliance, stop shall be installed for each appliance.

(5) All furnances, space heaters and hot water tanks shall be properly vented outside.

(6) Customer shall not adjust or attempt to adjust company's installed regulators, meters, or facilities. And shall be responsible for any damage to meter and regulator, unless same is rendered by unknown persons, in which event same shall be immediately reported to company.

(7) Each customer shall be installed a separate meter, and no building having more than one tenant shall be served by a single meter.

(8) Meter reading shall be between the 20-27th of each month, and mailing on or before the 1st day of each month.

~~(9) Accounts not paid 10 days after mailing date shall be subject to 10% penalty on total billing. (Is deleted per Order 10-30-80, Case No. 7768)~~

Customer accounts not paid within 15 days from statement mailing date shall be charged a penalty of 5% on the unpaid balance of customer's bill.

(10) Re-connect for customers who discontinue service during summer months \$15.00.

(11) Transfer service charge for customer moving from one location to another \$20.00.

(12) Service charge of \$15.00 for collection of delinquent bill after written notice to the customer stating that if the bill is not paid by a certain date, the service will be disconnected.

(13) To reconnect a service that has been disconnected for non-payment of bill, a service charge for disconnecting and re-connection shall be \$15.00.

(14) Budget Payment Plan:

The budget amount is arrived at by the customer's usage at his present address, taking the usage cost for the previous 12 month period, dividing same by 12 which gives the monthly budget plan amount. The May billing the following year would be the adjusted amount due company or credit due customer; the following is sample of plan calculation:
