RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Change in Rate

Whenever a change occurs in rates of a supplier 1/ of the Company, the Company shall submit to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky as soon as practicable an application Company's gas sales which shall be determined as follows:

- (1) The effect per Mcf of sales due to the change in cost of gas shall be determined by:
 - (a) Applying the rates of the currently effective supplier tariffs or agreements to:
 - (I) The Company's most recent billing demands, applicable to each such Sales Rate Schedule, and
 - (II) The volume of gas purchased, applicable to each Sales Rate Schedule, by the Company during the most recently available 12 month period.

1/ Supplier shall include all historic gas resources and any non-historic gas supply; however, non-historic sources, without further authorization, shall be limited to SPQ Gas. Acquisition of SPQ Gas, and any rate of volumetric change therein, and cost of transportation thereof shall be considered as a change in rates of charges.

- (b) Dividing the cost of gas calculated in (a) above by the volume of gas purchased during the 12 month period, and comparing the resulting quotient to the proforma average cost per Mcf of gas purchased computed at the supplier rates.

- (a) Refund to its customers as a credit to each customer billed over a period not to exceed 4 months commencing not more than 60 days after the date of receipt of the refund, and amount determined as follows:
 - (1) Divide refund amount by the estimate of sales under such rate schedules for the period specified in (B-1-a) above to determine the refund factor, which shall be applicable to the volumes billed to customers that month.
- (b) The Company shall not be required to refund an amount for which the associated credit factor would be insignificant but will accumulate all refunds until the aggregate amounts to a sum that warrants the expense of refunding.
- (c) The refund factor as computed shall be adjusted, if necessary, to insure refund of the total amount computed under (B-1-a) above.
- C. The Company will file with the Commission a copy of computation of the change in rate or refund credit and verification of its supplier's change in price or refunds at least fifteen days prior to the effective date of a change in rate or commencement date of refund credits to its customers.
- D. When the change in rate including purchases from other than pipeline supplier, the Company shall supply the Commission with details of such purchases and copies of any contracts relative thereto.

AVERAGE COST OF GAS

The average cost of gas as of the effective date proposed rates calculated as provided herein has been determined to be \$4.653 for the Pendleton County Water District, Gas Division Service Areas.

COLLECTION AND TERMINATION SCHEDULES

All gas bills are due and payable by the due date as set forth on each bill. (Due date is 10 days after mailing.) If the bill is not paid on or before the due date, a 10% penalty will be added to the amount due.

A customer shall be given 10 days written termination notice before discontinuance of service for non-payment, but the cut off will not be effected before 30 days after the mailing date of the original bill.

A reconnection charge of fifteen dollars (\$15) shall apply for reconnection of a service discontinued for non-payment or violation of rules and regulations. A collection charge of ten dollars (\$10) shall be charged if necessary to send service personnel to collect an account after termination notice has been served and expired per existing Public Service Commission Rules.

If a customer questions that this bill is not accurate, we have an employee available during regular working to answer questions regarding the bill and to resolve disputes.

If a customer is unable to pay the full bill, we have an employee available during regular working hours who has the authority to negotiate payment plans of ourstanding bills and to accept payments

If a customer believes that discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity of someone residing at the affected premises, then they can obtain up to 30 days to make other living arrangements by obtaining a written certificate from a physician, a registered nurse, or a public health officer stating that in the opinion of the person making the certification, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises. If such a certificate is filed with our office, then we will not disconnect until they have time to make alternate living

arrangements or until 30 days after we have informed them of the existence of various local, state, and federal programs that might be able to assist them in paying their bills, whichever occurs first.

If they are unable to pay their bill and currently receive AFDC, medicaid, food stamps, or have gross income at or below 130% of the federal poverty guidelines, they should contact the nearest office of the Department for Human Resources Bureau of Social Insurance. If they are unable to provide direct assistance, the customer can obtain a 30-Day extension to work out a payment plan by obtaining a written certification from that office and bringing it to our office. If the customer obtains such a certification and makes a good faith offer to make a present payment and agrees to pay all of the past due bill by October 15, we will accept the payment plan.

If a customer pays an account by check and the check is returned for non-sufficient funds by their bank, a \$5.00 Service Fee shall be charged.

When a customer questions a meter reading and requests that a re-read of their meter be performed, and the re-read of the meter proved the original reading to be correct, a charge of \$5.00 shall be charged for this service.

When a customer questions the accuracy of a meter servicing their property and the meter has been tested within the required Public Service Commission test periods, and said meter is removed, re-tested, and is accurate within the Public Service Commission guidelines, a testing charge of \$12.50 shall be charged. No charge shall be made if the meter is not within the Public Service Commission guidelines or the meter has not been tested within the Public Service Commission test periods.

DEPOSIT REQUIREMENTS

The required deposit will be 2/12 of the annual bill. (Total of the previous 12 months bill divided by 12 x 2.) If no prior service has been available at a particular residence an estimated deposit will be required based on the connect load. The deposit must be paid in full prior to turning on gas service. A receipt of deposit showing the name of the customer, location of the premises occupied, date and amount of deposit will be given at time of deposit payment. Interest in the amount of 6% per annum is paid on all deposits from the date of deposit.

BUDGET BILLING

Consumers have an opportunity to sign agreements with the district for spreading billing evenly over a twelve month period. The billing is based on estimated consumption made by a District Representative. In May, the end of the twelve month period, the difference between payments and actual usage is adjusted by adding or crediting the difference of the regular gas service bill. A copy of the agreement is make a part of the District's Rules and Regulations.

BUDGET PAYMENT PLAN AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made in duplicate between Pendleton Co. Water District, Gas Division, a Kentucky Corporation with its principal office at 400 Main St., Falmouth, Kentucky (hereinafter called the "District") and _____ (hereinafter called the "Consumer") located at _____.

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of Consumer's request to make Natural Gas service payments under the District's Budget Payment Plan, the Consumer shall pay the District at a fixed amount each month in lieu of monthly billings based on actual usage; whereby, any difference in the actual amount due and the fixed amount paid each month shall be payable in full each year upon receipt of the June billing.

It is further agreed:

1. The Consumer agrees that if at any time the Rate under which the District's purchases Natural Gas service at wholesale is modified, the District may make a corresponding modification in the rate for service hereunder and the budget payment amount shall be adjusted accordingly.
2. The Consumer agrees that if at any time the Rates and/or Terms and Conditions as set forth in the District's Rate are adjusted or changed and said adjustments and/or changes are approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission said adjustments and/or will become effective and supercede, cancel and replace rates and/or terms and conditions provided in existing rate prior to the effective date as set forth in the Energy Regulatory Commission's Order approving the adjustments and/or changes.
3. The Consumer agrees that monthly budget payments are subject to change where a trend develops indicating the amount set up is insufficient to result in a reasonable balance due in the June Billing Period; at which time, the difference in the fixed amount and actual cost of Natural Gas service is payable in full.
4. It is agreed that the Consumer shall make payment each month in the full amount of the Budget Payment as stated herein, irregardless of any accumulated charges credits for actual use. The accumulated charges or credits shall be adjusted on the June billing. Should the Consumer fail to make such budget payments by due date, service will be discontinued and entire balance becomes due and payable before service is restored. The Consumer shall be ineligible for future billings under the Budget Payment Plan.

The Consumer agrees that if at any time the Rates and/or Terms and Conditions as set forth in the District's Rate are adjusted or changed and said adjustments and/or changes are approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission said adjustments and/or will become effective and supercede, cancel and replace rates and/or terms and conditions provided in existing rate prior to the effective date as set forth in the Energy Regulatory Commission's Order approving the adjustments and/or changes.

The Consumer agrees that monthly budget payments are subject to change where a trend develops indicating the amount set up is insufficient to result in a reasonable balance due in the June Billing Period; at which time, the difference in the fixed amount and actual cost of Natural Gas service is payable in full.
4. It is agreed that the Consumer shall make payment each month in the full amount of the Budget Payment as stated herein, irregardless of any accumulated charges credits for actual use. The accumulated charges or credits shall be adjusted on the June billing. Should the Consumer fail to make such budget payments by due date, service will be discontinued and entire balance becomes due and payable before service is restored.  - (II) The volume of gas purchased, applicable to each Sales Rate Schedule, by the Company during the most recently available 12 month period.

1/ Supplier shall include all historic gas resources and any non-historic gas supply; however, non-historic sources, without further authorization, shall be limited to SPQ Gas. Acquisition of SPQ Gas, and any rate of volumetric change therein, and cost of transportation thereof shall be considered as a change in rates of charges.

- (b) Dividing the cost of gas calculated in (a) above by the volume of gas purchased during the 12 month period, and comparing the resulting quotient to the proforma average cost per Mcf of gas purchased computed at the supplier rates.

AVERAGE COST OF GAS

The average cost of gas as of the effective date proposed rates calculated as provided herein has been determined to be \$4.653 for the Pendleton County Water District, Gas Division Service Areas.

COLLECTION AND TERMINATION SCHEDULES

All gas bills are due and payable by the due date as set forth on each bill. (Due date is 10 days after mailing.) If the bill is not paid on or before the due date, a 10% penalty will be added to the amount due.

A customer shall be given 10 days written termination notice before discontinuance of service for non-payment, but the cut off will not be effected before 30 days after the mailing date of the original bill. A reconnection charge of fifteen dollars (\$15) shall apply for reconnection of a service discontinued for non-payment or violation of rules and regulations. A collection charge of ten dollars (\$10) shall be charged if necessary to send service personnel to collect an account after termination notice has been served and expired per existing Public Service Commission Rules.

If a customer questions that this bill is not accurate, we have an employee available during regular working to answer questions regarding the bill and to resolve disputes.

If a customer is unable to pay the full bill, we have an employee available during regular working hours who has the authority to negotiate payment plans of ourstanding bills and to accept payments.

If a customer believes that discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity of someone residing at the affected premises, then they can obtain up to 30 days to make other living arrangements by obtaining a written certificate from a physician, a registered nurse, or a public health officer stating that in the opinion of the person making the certification, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises. If such a certificate is filed with our office, then we will not disconnect until they have time to make alternate living

arrangements or until 30 days after we have informed them of the existence of various local, state, and federal programs that might be able to assist them in paying their bills, whichever occurs first.

If they are unable to pay their bill and currently receive AFDC, medicaid, food stamps, or have gross income at or below 130% of the federal poverty guidelines, they should contact the nearest office of the Department for Human Resources Bureau of Social Insurance. If they are unable to provide direct assistance, the customer can obtain a 30-Day extension to work out a payment plan by obtaining a written certification from that office and bringing it to our office. DEPOSIT REQUIREMENTS

The required deposit will be 2/12 of the annual bill. (Total of the previous 12 months bill divided by 12 x 2.) If no prior service has been available at a particular residence an estimated deposit will be required based on the connect load. The deposit must be paid in full prior to turning on gas service. A receipt of deposit showing the name of the customer, location of the premises occupied, date and amount of deposit will be given at time of deposit payment. Interest in the amount of 6% per annum is paid on all deposits from the date of deposit.

BUDGET BILLING

Consumers have an opportunity to sign agreements with the district for spreading billing evenly over a twelve month period. The billing is based on estimated consumption made by a District Representative. In May, the end of the twelve month period, the difference between payments and actual usage is adjusted by adding or crediting the difference of the regular gas service bill. A copy of the agreement is make a part of the District's Rules and Regulations.

BUDGET PAYMENT PLAN AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made in duplicate between Pendleton Co. Water District, Gas Division, a Kentucky Corporation with its principal office at 400 Main St., Falmouth, Kentucky (hereinafter called the "District") and _____ (hereinafter called the "Consumer") located at _____.

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of Consumer's request to make Natural Gas service payments under the District's Budget Payment Plan, the Consumer shall pay the District at a fixed amount each month in lieu of monthly billings based on actual usage; whereby, any difference in the actual amount due and the fixed amount paid each month shall be payable in full each year upon receipt of the June billing.

It is further agreed:

1. The Consumer agrees that if at any time the Rate under which the District's purchases Natural Gas service at wholesale is modified, the District may make a corresponding modification in the rate for service hereunder and the budget payment amount shall be adjusted accordingly.
2. The Consumer agrees that if at any time the Rates and/or Terms and Conditions as set forth in the District's Rate are adjusted or changed and said adjustments and/or changes are approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission said adjustments and/or will become effective and supercede, cancel and replace rates and/or terms and conditions provided in existing rate prior to the effective date as set forth in the Energy Regulatory Commission's Order approving the adjustments and/or changes.
3. The Consumer agrees that monthly budget payments are subject to change where a trend develops indicating the amount set up is insufficient to result in a reasonable balance due in the June Billing Period; at which time, the difference in the fixed amount and actual cost of Natural Gas service is payable in full.
4. It is agreed that the Consumer shall make payment each month in the full amount of the Budget Payment as stated herein, irregardless of any accumulated charges credits for actual use. The accumulated charges or credits shall be adjusted on the June billing. Should the Consumer fail to make such budget payments by due date, service will be discontinued and entire balance becomes due and payable before service is restored. The Consumer shall be ineligible for future billings under the Budget Payment Plan.
5. This agreement shall continue from year to year, unless terminated by either party giving to the other notice in writing, subject to the provision stated in #4 above.

THEREUPON, it is agreed that _____ (Consumer) shall pay to Pendleton Co. Water District, Gas Division each month, beginning with July billing, for Natural Gas service in the amount of \$ _____ under this Budget Billing Agreement, and shall pay in full annually the balance resulting from difference in actual usage and fixed amount paid each month in June billing. If a credit balance (overpayment) exceeds \$10.00 it shall be refunded upon request. Any credit balance less than \$10.00 will be applied on the succeeding month's bill.
