LINE RELOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate facilities, the cost will be paid by party or parties requesting such relocation.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice, for failure to comply with its rules and regulations or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for nonpayment of bills. If discontinuance is for nonpayment of bills, the customer shall be given at least forty-eight (48) hours written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effected not less than twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the Utility a written certification, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may not be effected until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until not less than ten (10) days elapse from the date of the Utility's notification. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service shall be cut off without notice or refused. The customer shall pay the Utility the actual cost incurred by the Utility in disconnecting service, and in reconnecting service after the amounts owed by the customer, including the amount of any judgment, have been paid in full.

**RATES AND CHARGES**

1. Cedarbrook Utilities adopts all applicable Commission regulations for all instances not covered by the regulations of the company.
2. Bills: Bills are rendered monthly by the 10<sup>th</sup> and are due by the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month.
3. Late payment charge: A late payment or delinquent charge of 10% of the monthly bill shall be made when the bill is not paid within 20 days from the original mailing date of the bill. The Utility may charge a bad check fee of \$20 for all returned checks.
4. Deposit: A deposit not to exceed 2/12 of the estimated annual bill may be required prior to receiving service. The deposit shall be returned upon discontinuance of service and payment of all charges. Interest will be paid on deposits as required by KRS 278.460.
5. In the event that a complaint is filed in court to collect the amount the customer owes the Utility, the customer shall pay the legal and transportation fees and the Utility shall be entitled to recover from the customer the amount due plus court costs.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This schedule of Rules and Regulations governs the furnishing of sewage service by the Utility and applies to all service received from the Utility. All Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations. For situations not covered by the regulations of the company, the company adopts all applicable regulations of the PSC.

REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

SUBSTANCES NOT TO BE DISCHARGED INTO SEWERS

No substances shall be placed or discharged into the sanitary sewer system which will create a combustible, gaseous, explosive or inflammable condition in such sewer system nor shall any substances or objects be placed or discharged into the sewer system which will not dissolve and which will thus cause an obstruction and clogging within the system. No petroleum products shall be placed or discharged into the system. No storm water or surface water drain shall be connected with the sanitary sewer system nor shall any storm or surface water be otherwise introduced into the sewer system. If anyone is found to be dumping illegal substances into the system their service will be discontinued immediately.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SEWER FAILURE

The Utility is responsible for sewer failure only when in control of the Utility's employees. No consumer is paid damages for equipment unless such damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of negligence on the part of the Utility or its employees.

PROTECTION BY CONSUMER

Consumer shall protect the equipment of the Utility on his premises and shall not interfere with Utility's property or permit interference except by duly authorized representatives of the Utility.

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

MAINTENANCE

The Utility may at any time deemed necessary, suspend sewer service to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of its system. The Utility shall give reasonable notice of such suspension of service to the consumer.
