RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Meters shall be read between the 20th and the 25th of the month. Bill shall be mailed on or before the 1st.
2. All bills must be paid within ten (10) days of the billing date.
3. A penalty of 10% shall be added to all bills not paid within ten (10) days of the billing date.
4. Service shall be discontinued on the 27th of the month for any account delinquent on that date upon at least 48 hours written notice under the conditions set forth in 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.
5. A service charge of \$10.00 shall be made on any cut-off meter because of delinquency before service can be restored, or to set meter.
6. All customers shall make a deposit against water bills of two-twelfths (2/12) of what the utility manager shall estimate to be the annual bill of the customer or applicant.
7. Anyone requesting meter to be checked, and meter found not to be faulty, shall be responsible for \$10.00 service charge for removing and replacing meter. If meter is found to be faulty, utility shall be responsible for fee.
8. All service pipe and meters are the property of the utility.
9. The bills shall be paid at Auxier Water Company Office, presently at Auxier, Kentucky.
10. Complaints may be made to the utility President and manager, Auxier Water Company Office, Auxier, Kentucky, during regular business hours.
11. The utility may make contracts it deems in the best interest of the utility for the extension of the water mains of the utility and for service to mobile home parks and industrial and commercial users and such customers are not entitled to such special service in the absence

of special contracts with the utility, subject to approval of the Utility Regulatory Commission.

12. All taps and connections to the mains of the utility shall be made by and/or under the directions and supervision of utility personnel.
13. Water service may be discontinued by the utility for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition of service and especially for any of the following reasons: subject to the notice requirements of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.
 1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 2. Failure to report to the utility, additions to the property of fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 3. Resale or giving away of water.
 4. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep in suitable state of repair.
 5. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or valves, or permitting such tampering by others.
 6. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separated water supply to premises which receive water from the district.
 7. Non-payment of bills.
14. Any customer desiring to discontinue utility water service to the premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in writing or in person at the business office of the utility; otherwise a customer shall remain liable for all water used.

and service rendered by the utility until said notice is received by the utility.

- 15. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the district will be mailed to the customer at the address filed in writing with the utility, including change of address filed in writing with the utility; and the utility shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.
- 16. All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the utility and the utility reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used.
- 17. In the event a meter in service upon periodic request or complaint test is found to be more than 2% in error, the provisions of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 9, as the same may be amended from time to time, shall apply as to bill adjustment.
- 18. Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water consumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register.
- 19. The utility shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and when such interruptions occur, will endeavor to re-establish service with the shortest possible delay, but when the service is interrupted all consumers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.
- 20. The utility shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for the necessary repairs.

No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the utility may be deemed necessary.

- 21. Customers having boilers and/or pressure vehicles receiving a supply of water from the utility must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the steam line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the utility is disconnected or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice.
- 22. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the District.
- 23. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the utility lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accesible at all times.
- 24. The customer's service line shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the utility rules and regulations and with the regulations of the Department of Health.
- 25. Damage to Auxier Water System. No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the system's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to discontinuation of water service and may be required to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the pipe or appurtenance, if so determined by a court of law having jurisdiction.
- 26. Water furnished by the Utility may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell or give away the water to any other person.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 27. All customers shall grant or convey, or shall be caused to be granted or conveyed, to the Utility a perpetual easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said easement or right-of-way is necessary for the Utility water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish services to the customer.
- 28. This contract provides a 5/8" meter.
- 29. Upon request by a customer seeking an extension agreement with a refunding provision, upon payment for extension pursuant to the Utility extension agreement that in effect, the line will be constructed by the Utility. The customer shall be reimbursed by the District in accordance with and limited to the provisions of Section 12 Extension of Service 807 KAR 5:006, Regulation of Public Service Commission in effect at time of signing of extension agreement. This resolution, tariff and rules apply only to line extension agreements made from this date forward. There will be no refund as to past extensions.
- 30. The Utility may at its option accept contributions in aid of construction including extensions of its water system, built to Utility specifications and right-of-way requirements. Such contributions in aid of construction may consist of cash in any amount which the Utility may, if it sees fit, apply to its expenses related to such extension. In the event of any such contribution in aid of construction, the Utility will make no refund.
- 31. There will be a \$5.00 customer charge on each returned check.
- 32. Any customer requesting a temporary hookup will be charged the full cost of that hookup.
