RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Meters shall be read between the 20th and the 25th of the month. Bill shall be mailed on or before the first.
2. All bills must be paid within (10) days of the billing date.
3. A penalty of 10% shall be added to all bills not paid within ten (10) days of the billing date.
4. Service shall be discontinued on the 27th of the month for any account delinquent on that date upon at least 48 hours written notice under conditions set forth in 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.
5. A Service reconnection charge of \$ 10.00 shall be made for reconnecting a customer's meter that was cut off because of delinquency before service can be restored, or to set meter.
6. A service charge of \$10.00 shall be made for any Auxier Water ("Utility") employee requested to report to customer residents to turn meter off due to leak on customers side of the meter.
7. All customers shall make a deposit against water bills two-twelfth (2/12) of what the utility manager shall estimate to be the annual bill of the customer of applicant.
8. Anyone requesting meter to be checked and meter found not to be faulty, shall be responsible for \$10.00 service charge for removing and replacing meter. If meter is found to be faulty, Utility shall be responsible for fee. If a periodic test of the meter is due or past due per 807 KAR 5:066 (17), no charge will be made for the test.
9. All service pipe and meters are the property of the Utility.
10. The bills shall be paid at the Auxier Water Company Office, presently at Auxier, Kentucky.
11. Complaints may be made to the Utility President and Manager Auxier Water Company Office, Auxier, Kentucky during regular business hours.

12. The Utility may make contracts it deems in the best interest of the Utility for the extension of the water mains of the Utility and for service to mobile home parks and industrial and commercial users and such customers are not entitled to such special service in the absence of special contracts with Utility, subject to approval of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
13. All taps and connections to the mains of the Utility shall be made by and/or under the directions and supervision of Utility personnel.
14. Water Service may be discontinued by the Utility for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition of service and especially for any of the following reasons: subject to the notice requirements of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.
 1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property of fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 2. Failure to report to the Utility, additions to the property of fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 3. Resale or giving away of water.
 4. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep in suitable state of repair.
 5. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service of valves or permitting such tampering by others.
 6. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separated water supply to premises which receive water from the Utility.
 7. Non-Payment of bills.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

15. Any customer desiring to discontinue the Utility's water service to their premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in writing or in person at the business office of the Utility; otherwise, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered by the Utility until said notice is received by the Utility.
16. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the Utility will be mailed to the customer at the address filed in writing with the Utility, including change of address filed in writing with the Utility; and the Utility shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.
17. All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the Utility and the Utility reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used.
18. In the event a meter is service upon periodic request or complaint test is found to be more than 2% in error, the provisions of 807KAR 5:0006, Section 9, as the same may be amended from time to time shall apply as to bill adjustment.
19. Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water consumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register.
20. The Utility shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and when such interruptions occur, will endeavor to re-establish service with the shortest possible delay, but when the service is interrupted all consumers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.

- 21. The Utility shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking up of any service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery of stoppage for the necessary repairs. No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the Utility may be deemed necessary.
- 22. Customers having boilers and/or pressure vehicles receiving a supply fo water from the Utility must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the steam line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the Utility is disconnected or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice.
- 23. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the Utility.
- 24. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed the connections are conveniently located with respect to the Utility lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all time.
- 25. The customer's service line and valve shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expence in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the Utility's rules and regulations and with the regulations of the Department of Health.
- 26. Damage To Utility Property: No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, destroy, damage, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the Utility's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to discontinuation of water service and may be required to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the pipe or appurtenance, if so determined by court of law having jurisdiction.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

27. Water furnished by the Utility may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell or give away the water to any other person.
28. All customers shall grant or convey, or shall be caused to be granted or conveyed, to the Utility a perpetual easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said easement or right of way is necessary for the Utility water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish services to the customer.
29. The Utility's standard residential meter is 5/8" x 3/4".
30. Upon request and payment by a customer seeking an extension agreement with a refunding provision, for extension pursuant to the "Utility Extension Agreement" that in effect, the line will be constructed by the Utility. The customer shall be reimbursed by the Utility in accordance with and limited to the provisions of Section 12, Extension of Service 807 KAR 5:0006, Regulation of the Kentucky Public Service Commission in effect at time of signing of the extension agreement. This resolution, tariff and rules apply only to line extension agreements made from this date forward. There will be no refund as to past extensions.
31. The Utility may at its option accept contributions in aid of construction including extensions of its water system, built to Utility specifications and right of way requirements. Such contributions in aid of construction may consist of a cash in any amount which the Utility may, if it sees fit, apply to its expenses related to such extension. In the event of any such contribution in aid of construction, the Utility will make no refund.
32. There will be a \$5.00 customer charge on each returned check.
33. Any customer requesting a temporary hookup will be charged the full cost of that hookup.

34. Customer's Service Line: All service line beyond the metering point should be installed of material consisting of copper, or P.V.C. pipe with rating of not less than 2000 P.S.I., the size of service line beyond the metering point should not be less than 3/4" inch, however, a larger size may be needed to provide adequate service. If the customer's point of use is a higher elevation than the point of delivery, the customer should consult with a reputable engineering firm to size the service line from metering point to residence.

35. Additional Load: The service connection supplied by the Utility for each customer has a definite capacity, and no addition to the equipment or load connected thereto will be allowed except by the consent of the Utility. Failure to give notice of addition's or changes in load, and to obtain the Utility's consent for same shall render the customer liable for any damage to any of the Utility's lines or equipment caused by the additional or changed installation, and shall constitute theft of service.

- *36. Nonstandard Service : Customer shall pay the cost of any special installation necessary to meet his particular requirements for service other than a standard water tap.
- *37. Scope: This schedule of Rules and Regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the company whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application's or otherwise. A copy of this schedule together with a copy of the Company's schedule of Rates and Charges, shall be kept open to inspect at the office of the Company.
- *38. Relocation of Water Facilities: Company may, at the request of customers, relocate or change existing company owned equipment. Customer shall reimburse company for such changes at actual cost including appropriate overhead, upon, presentation by the company of an itemized invoice of charges.
- *39. Revisions: These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed from time to time by either of the two following methods:
 - A. By order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission upon formal application by the Utility, and after hearing as KAR 5:011 section 6 (3) (B).
 - B. By issuing and filing on at least twenty (20) days notice to the KY P.S.C. and the Public all proposed changes in the Rules and Regulations, as provided by KY P.S.C. Regulations set forth in 807 KAR. 5:011 section 6 (3) (B).
