RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Meters shall be read between the 20th and the 25th of the month. Bill shall be mailed on or before the first.
2. All bills must be paid within (10) days of the billing date.
3. A penalty of 10% shall be added to all bills not paid within ten (10) days of the billing date, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 8(3)(h).
4. Service shall be discontinued on the 27th of the month for any account delinquent on that date upon at least five (5) days written notice under conditions set forth in 807 KAR 5:006, Section 14. Such termination notice shall be exclusive of and separate from the original bill.
5. The Company requires a minimum cash deposit to secure payment of bills. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 74.050, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

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The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required.

The Company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

1. Previous payment history with the Company. If the customer has no previous history with the Company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
2. Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.

3. Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area.
4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.
5. Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.
6. Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or 10 percent for a non-residential customer, the Company may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

Residential customers will pay equal deposits in the amount of \$60.00. This amount does not exceed the average bill of residential customers served by the Company and is equal to 2/12 of the average annual bill.

6. All service pipe and meters are the property of the Utility.
7. The bills shall be paid at the Auxier Water Company Office, presently at Auxier, Kentucky.
8. Complaints may be made to the Utility President and Manager, Auxier Water Company office, Auxier, Kentucky during regular business hours.
9. The Utility may make contracts it deems in the best interest of the utility for the extension of the water mains of the Utility and for service to mobile home parks and industrial and commercial users and such customers are not entitled to such special service in the absence of special contracts with Utility, subject to approval of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
10. All taps and connections to the mains of the Utility shall be made by and/or under the directions and supervision of Utility personnel.

11. Water service may be discontinued by the Utility for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition of service and especially for any of the following reasons: subject to the notice requirement of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 14.
 1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property of fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 2. Failure to report to the Utility, additions to the property of fixtures to be supplied or additional use to made of water.
 3. Resale or giving away of water.
 4. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep in suitable state of repair.
 5. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service of valves or permitting such tampering by others.
 6. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separated water supply to premises which receive water from the Utility.
 7. Non-payment of bills.
12. Any customer desiring to discontinue the Utility's water service to their premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in writing or in person at the business office of the Utility; otherwise, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered by the Utility until said notice is received by the Utility. Notice may also be given by telephone.
13. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the Utility will be mailed to the customer at the address filed in writing with the Utility, including change of address filed in writing with the Utility; and the Utility shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.

21. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that the connections are conveniently located with respect to the Utility lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.
22. The customer's service line and valve shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the Utility's rules and regulations and with the regulations of the Department of Health.
23. Damage To Utility Property: No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, destroy, damage, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the Utility's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to discontinuation of water service and may be required to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the pipe or appurtenance, if so determined by court of law having jurisdiction.
24. Water furnished by the Utility may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell or give away the water to any other person.
25. All customers shall grant or convey, or shall be caused to be granted or conveyed, to the Utility a perpetual easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said easement or right-of-way is necessary for the Utility water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish services to the customer.
26. The Utility's standard residential meter is 5/8" x 3/4".
27. Upon request and payment by a customer seeking an extension agreement with a refunding provision, for extension pursuant to the "Utility Extension Agreement" that in effect, the line will be constructed by the Utility. The customer shall be reimbursed by the Utility in accordance with and limited to the provisions of Section 12, Extension of Service 807 KAR 5:006, Regulation of the Kentucky Public Service Commission in effect at time of signing of the extension agreement. This resolution, tariff and rules apply only to line extension ~~public service commissions~~ from this date forward. There will be no refund as to past ~~extensions~~ **EXTENSIONS**.

- 28. The Utility may at its option accept contributions in aid of construction including extensions of its water system, built to Utility specifications and right of way requirements. Such contributions in aid of construction may consist of a cash in any amount which the Utility may, if it sees fit, apply to its expenses related to such extension. In the event of any such contribution in aid of construction, the Utility will make no refund.
- 29. Customer's Service Line: All service line beyond the metering point should be installed of material consisting of copper, or P.V.C. pipe with rating of not less than 200 P.S.I., the size of service line beyond the metering point should not be less than 3/4", however, a larger size may be needed to provide adequate service. If the customer's point of use is a higher elevation than the point of delivery, the customer should consult with a reputable engineering firm to size the service line from metering point to residence.
- 30. Additional Load: The service connection supplied by the Utility for each customer has a definite capacity, and no addition of the equipment or load connected thereto will be allowed except by the consent of the Utility. Failure to give notice of addition's or changes in load, and to obtain the Utility's consent for same shall render the customer liable for any damage to any of the Utility's lines or equipment caused by the additional or changed installation, and shall constitute theft of service.
- 31. Nonstandard Service: Customer shall pay the cost of any special installation necessary to meet his particular requirements for service other than a standard water tap.
- 32. Scope: This schedule of Rules and Regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the Company whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application's or otherwise. A copy of this schedule together with a copy of the Company's schedule of Rates and Charges, shall be kept open to inspect at the office of the Company.

33. Relocation of Water Facilities: Company may, at the request of customers, relocate or change existing Company owned equipment. Customer shall reimburse Company for such changes at actual cost including appropriate overhead, upon, presentation by the Company of an itemized invoice of charges.
34. Revisions: These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed from time to time by either of the two following methods:
- A. By order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission upon formal application by the Utility, and after hearing as KAR 5:011 Section 6 (3) (B).
 - B. By issuing and filing on at least thirty (30) days notice to the KY P.S.C. and the public, all proposed changes in the Rules and Regulations, as provided by KY P.S.C. Regulations set forth in 807 KAR 5:011 Section 6 (3) (B).
35. Auxier Water Company, Inc. Inc. shall not be liable to any persons for the failure of fire hydrants, or the inadequacy of water volume or pressure, in the event such failure or inadequacy in any way causes or contributes to a fire loss.
36. Monitoring of Customer Usage At least once annually the Company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:
- 1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12-month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.
 - 2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customers, no further review will be done.

3. If the annual usages differ by 50 percent or more and cannot be attributed to a readily identified common cause, the Company will compare the customer's monthly usage records for the 12-month period with the monthly usage for the same months of the preceding year.
4. If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined from analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, the Company will contact the customer by telephone or in writing to determine whether there have been changes such as different number of household members or work staff, additional or different appliances, changes in business volume, or known leaks in the customer's service line.
5. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the Company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows an average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
6. The Company will notify the customers of the investigation, its findings, and any refunds or back billing in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the Company will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to its attention as a result of its on-going meter reading or billing processes or customer inquiry.

37. Budget Payment Plan The Company has a budget payment plan available for its residential customers whereby a customer may elect to pay a monthly amount for the budget year in lieu of monthly or bimonthly billings for actual usage. The monthly budget payment will be determined by the Company based, under normal circumstances, on a minimum of one-twelfth of the estimated annual usage, subject to review and adjustment during the budget year. The normal budget year for all residential customers is the 12 months from February to January with January being the settlement month.

The customer's account may be adjusted through a series of levelized adjustments on a monthly basis if usage indicates that the account will not be current upon payment of the last budget amount.

SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

The following charges for special services shall be made:

1. Turn-on Charge A turn-on charge of \$25 shall be made for a new service turn-on, seasonal turn-on or temporary service, during regular working hours. A turn-on charge shall not be made for initial installation of service where a tap-fee is applicable. If service is turned on other than during regular working hours, the charge shall be \$30.
2. Reconnect Charge A reconnect charge of \$25 shall be made to reconnect a service which has been terminated for non-payment of bills or violation of the utility's rules or commission regulations. If reconnected after regular working hours, the charge shall be \$30.
3. Termination or Field Collection Charge A charge of \$25 shall be made for a trip to the premises of a customer for the purpose of terminating service. The charge shall be assessed if the utility representative actually terminates service or if, in the course of the trip, the customer pays the delinquent bill to avoid termination. The charge shall be made if the utility representative agrees to delay termination based on the customer's agreement to pay the delinquent bill by a specific date. The utility may make a field collection charge only once in any billing period.
4. Meter Test Charge A charge of \$25 plus actual cost of the meter test, shall be assessed if a customer requests the meter be tested pursuant to Section 18 of the regulation, and the test shows the meter is not more than two percent (2%) fast. No charge shall be made if the test shows the meter is more than two percent (2%) fast.
5. Special Meter Reading Charge A charge of \$25 shall be assessed when a customer requests that a meter be reread, and the second reading shows the original reading was correct.
6. Meter Resetting Charge A charge of \$25 per trip shall be made for resetting a meter if the meter has been removed at the customer's request.

43. Auxier Water Co., Inc. shall provide free or reduced rate service to the following: Forrest Music, President, and Philip Ward, Vice-President of the Company. Also, the Company will provide free or reduced rate service to the Auxier Volunteer Fire Department to provide water for the needs of the Fire Department. The fire department is required to maintain estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training and report the usage on a monthly basis to Auxier.
