RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any resident within the boundries of the Buechel Water District is eligible for any service from the District.

2. Application for Service and Contract:

A. Where and how made:

Application for service, whether for original service connection or for regular service connection by a Consumer shall be made at the office of The District and shall be upon forms available at the District Office.

B. Deposit:

The application shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$5.00 to assure payment of the service and, where the application is for original service connection, the additional sum of money required by these regulations to meet the cost of the service connection and tap-on fee. No interest shall be paid on the deposit thus made.

C. Time of Contract:

The application shall become a binding contract between the Consumer and the District when approved by the District.

D. Termination of Contract:

The contract shall be binding between the parties until terminated as hereinafter set out:

1. The Consumer may terminate the contract by giving written notice of his desire to terminate, and by paying for the water used during the month of termination plus any balance due the District for any previous service. The deposit made at the time of the application may be used by the Consumer to meet the payment required under this subsection provided the said deposit is sufficient to meet the payment. Failure

E. New Contract after cancellation for cause.

Any Consumer whose contract has been cancelled by the District for cause as set forth in Regulation 2 shall before service is recommended enter into a new contract which may be done only and at the option of the District and upon such reasonable conditions as the District shall impose which may include, in addition to the deposit.

1. Payment by consumer of all charges under old or cancelled contract including fees for turning on services.
2. Any other reasonable conditions.

3. Original Service Connection.

A. By whom installed and rates.

All original service connections shall be made by the District and the applicant shall pay for such connections in accordance with the following schedule:

1. For normal tap on and connection without rock excavation:

2. Where rock is encountered same as above plus actual cost of necessary rock excavation.

B. Separate meter for each separate property:

Each separate parcel or real estate shall be served only through its separate connection containing its own meter except that, in cases when this is impossible or impracticable the District may waive this requirement in writing and authorize some other service

arrangement which shall continue at the will of the District until such disability or impracticability has been removed.

C. Each separate property shall be served only from the water main in the street upon which the residence or business faces or abuts, except in cases where it is impossible or impracticable to meet this requirement. The District may waive this arrangement which shall continue at the will of the District, until such disability or impracticability has been removed.

D. The water meter shall be placed at the property line of the Consumer at an adjacent point thereto agreeable to both the Consumer and the District except that, in case of disagreement, the District shall determine the location which shall be reasonable.

E. Change in location of meter:

If a Consumer decides to relocate the meter on his property the same shall be done only by agreement with the District and upon the payment by the Consumer to the District of the complete cost of the change and relocation.

4. Extension of Water Mains.

A. Any person, body, firm or corporation which desires the District to extend its mains to serve such person or such persons and others shall file with the District an "Application for extension of water main" which application shall contain the name or names of the parties desiring the extension together with an estimate of the number of gallons of water to be used by such persons per month (which may be minimum bill per parcel or ground) and two copies of detailed plans showing the main extension desired.

B. Upon receipt of the application the District shall obtain an estimated

cost of laying the requested main, fire hydrants, and appurtenances including engineering cost, construction cost, plus administrative cost.

C. The District shall notify the applicant of the estimated cost as above, and the applicant shall either cancel the application or shall then advance to the District, the amount of money shown by the estimate and agree to pay actual cost of rock excavation. Whereupon the District shall proceed to take bids for the construction of the main and may contract and proceed to the construction of the main if a bid is received within the estimated cost, or, if the District is willing to pay the difference between the lowest and best bid and the estimated cost. If no bid is received within the estimated cost, or the District is not willing to assume the additional cost, the applicant shall be notified and given an opportunity to either pay the additional amount required or to cancel the application.


D. The District shall enter into a contract with any applicant who has paid for the extension of a main under this Regulation, and has a potential of 10 customers.

Tapping Privileges & Ownership

From and after the laying and completion of said line of pipe, it shall be owned solely by and be under the exclusive control and management of the District and said District shall have the right to extend said line of pipe or make connections thereto for other extensions of water mains, both for itself and for other parties who may make proper application for each extension without the consent of said Consumer. It is understood, however, that the Consumer may charge other consumers along the line such sum or sums as may be approved by the District, for the privilege of tapping said pipe for the purpose of installing service to supply water to the property abutting on said line of pipe. Such sum or sums, when approved by the District shall be paid by the other consumers to the District. The District after making record of same shall pay such approved sum or sums to the Consumer. It is understood and agreed, however, that should the Consumer extend free tapping privileges or authorize reduced tapping fees, then or in any said events, the said Consumer, will be charged on this contract in the full amount and to the full extent of said uncollected tapping fees, calculated on the basis hereinbefore mentioned. Whenever the Consumer shall have received or been credited with such a sum from persons who may tap said pipe as equals the amount paid by the consumer for the construction of said pipe, without interest, then no further charge shall be made by the Consumer for the privilege of tapping said pipe, and he shall have no authority in connection therewith, said process to continue for a period of ten years unless a paid total cost has been theretofore refunded before the expiration of ten years.

Payment

No work will be started until \$ _____ has been deposited in the office of the District by the Consumer.

Refunding

When a minimum bill is in effect and being paid by the owner or occupant of each house in said subdivision, then the Consumer shall receive \$1.00 per month for each such installation in use, where a minimum bill is actually collected by the District, said outlay is to be the property of the Consumer and is to be held by the District for a period of 60 days after collection and is to be paid over to said Consumer after holding same for 60 days, said process to continue for a period of twenty years unless a said total cost has been theretofore refunded before the expiration of twenty years.

Heirs

The Consumer, his heirs or assignees are to receive the benefits hereinabove set out until he, his heirs or assignees have received the principal amount hereinabove referred to without interest.

Upon recovery by the Consumer of the principal amount expended under his contract is to receive nothing further and he is to receive no benefits thereunder after the expiration of a period of twenty years from the date of this contract.

Interest

It is agreed that the District shall have no obligation to the Consumer for interest charges of any kind.

Agreement

The Consumer agrees that the water mains will be laid after rough road excavation, but before any rock is spread on road. If it is found necessary to excavate any rock on crossing streets, the Consumer agrees to see that road contractor allows the pipe contractor to remove rock before final grade is made on roadway.

This contract must be accepted or rejected within the next _____ from _____.

B. In the event the meter of any Consumer cannot be read during any month, estimated bill will be sent and the meter reading and charges will be corrected on the following month's bill.

6. Billing Dates and Discounts.

A. Bills for metered service to Consumer will be rendered monthly, on or before the 10th day of each month.

B. Net bills may be paid on or before the 22nd of the month.

C. If the net amount is received after the 22nd of the month, the check or money order is held and the customer is notified of the balance due.


D. Accounts outstanding are notified by letter on the 24th of the month.

E. Failure to receive a bill does not entitle the Consumer to a discount.

F. Each customer is allowed to pay the net amount after the 22nd of the month one time during each calendar year.

7. Faulty Meters - Adjustment of bills.

When a meter has been determined by the District to be faulty the bill for service for the month or months during which such condition has continued shall be fixed at the average bill for the previous six months during which such meter was registering accurately, and if there is no such six months period, then the average for such shorter time during which water was used.

8. Delinquent Accounts.

Accounts unpaid after the last day of the month are considered delinquent. The Consumer will be required to pay the gross bill plus a \$3.00 service charge or service will be discontinued.

9. Temporary Discontinuance of Service and Meter Charge.

A Consumer who has complied with all the terms and conditions of his contract, may ask for temporary discontinuance of his service, which will be permitted by the District on the following conditions:

- A. If service is discontinued for a period of thirty (30) days or less the Consumer shall pay a minimum bill.
- B. If service is discontinued for a period of more than thirty (30) days, the Consumer shall pay the following; a fee of \$3.00 for discontinuing service plus \$3.00 for restoring service.

10. Places of Payment of Water Bills.

For the convenience of the Consumers, the District has four (4) sub-stations for the payment of net water bills.

Schedule #1

General Service

Applicable: - Within the service area of Buechel Water District.

Availability: - To domestic, farm, commercial and industrial customers.

Water shall be supplied by the District in accordance with the following rates:

A. For the first month's service or part thereof:

1. If the application is accepted by the District and the water is turned on between the 1st and the 15th of the month, the Consumer will be billed at least a minimum bill in the amount of \$3.61 for 3,000 gallons.
2. If the application is accepted by the District and the water is turned on between the 16th and the last day of the month, the Consumer will receive no bill unless 3,000 gallons of water is used.

B. For final month's service or part thereof:

1. If the Consumer terminates his contract during the first 10 days of the month any water used will be added to the current bill.
2. If the Consumer terminates his contract after the first 10 days of the month, any water consumed will be billed as a final bill at the standard rates.


Water for resale shall be provided by the District under separate contract.

General Information:

The Buechel Water District's supply of water is purchased from the Louisville Water Company, which conforms to all legal requirements of the State Department of Health. Tests are taken periodically by the State of Local Department of Health throughout the District.

Whenever the Buechel Water District finds it necessary to schedule an interruption of its service, all customers and Fire Departments affected are notified a minimum of two (2) days before the anticipated time of interruption. A complete record is kept of all major interruptions.

Pressure test are taken at least twice a year and copies kept in the District office and the Engineer's office.
