**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- A. All taps and connections to the mains of the District shall be made by and/or under the direction and supervision of District personnel.
- B. Water service may be discontinued by the District for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition of service and especially for any of the following reasons:
  1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
  2. Failure to report to the District additions to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
  3. Resale or giving away of water.
  4. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and or failure to keep in suitable state of repair.
  5. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or valves or permitting such tampering by others.
  6. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separated water supply to premises which receive water from the District.
  7. Non-payment of bills.
- C. Any customer desiring to discontinue the water service to his premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in writing at the business office of the District; otherwise, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered by the District until said notice is received by the District.
- D. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the users agreement unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.
- E. 1. Bills for water service are due and payable at the office of the District, or to any designated agent, on the date of issue. Bills past due date shall be the tenth day after the date of issue. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first day of each month.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

2. All bills not paid on or before the past due date shall be deemed delinquent. The district may serve a customer a written final notice of said delinquency. If delinquent bill is not paid within ten days after date of such final notice, the water supply to the customer may be discontinued without further notice.

3. Meters will be read monthly between the 15th and 20th of each month.

- F. Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$10.00 will be made for (I) reconnection of water service, but the reconnection will not be made until after all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed by the customer to the district have been paid.
- G. The District reserves the right to request a nominal sum be placed on deposit with the District for the purpose of establishing or maintaining any customers credit.
- H. All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the District and the District reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used.
- I. Upon written request of any customer, the meter serving said customer shall be tested by the District. Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within 12 months preceding the requested test; otherwise, a charge of \$5.00 will be made and then only if the test indicates (I) meter accuracy within the limits of 2%. If a meter is inaccurate in excess of 2%, adjustments shall be made for the two preceding months prior to test according to the inaccuracy in excess of 2%.
- J. Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water consumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register.
- K. The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and when such interruptions occur will endeavor to reestablish service with the shortest possible delay. When the service is interrupted, all consumers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- L. Customers having boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the district must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the steam line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice.
- M. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the District.
- N. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.
- O. The customer's service line shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the District rules and regulations and with the regulations of the Department of Health.
- P. If a loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customer, member of his household, his agent or employee, the cost ~~is~~ of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer.
- Q. Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the consumer, member of his household, and employees only. The consumer shall not sell or give away the water to any other person.
- R. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system whose decision may be appealed to the Board of Commissioners of the District within ten days; otherwise, the operator's decision will be final.
