

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 7. Any break in water line, or damage caused by anyone other than the Water District must be reported, and Water District reimbursed for such damage.
- 8. No fill, ditches, banks or any other disturbance can be started without notice to the Water District at least three (3) days before starting work after contract is let.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
2. Any resident of Lake City Water District is eligible for water service from the district.
3. A deposit of \$5.00 shall be required from each customer to guarantee payment of monthly bills.
4. When a rented or leased house has been vacant one month, meter will be removed at owner's consent. A charge of \$6.00 will be made for removal of meter, and a charge of \$5.00 will be made when meter is replaced. *See Sheet 1A Jew*
5. The Water District Commissioners will have full jurisdiction as to how and where meters are set, size and kind of lines used; and all matters pertaining to water lines, meters, easements, size, type, brand and grade of meter boxes, and any and all other matters pertaining to the Lake City Water District. No one or two Commissioners may make any decision, as all three must agree before any work can be passed on or started.
6. Water lines installed by customer must be so done according to specifications of the Lake City Water District, and may be taken over and serviced by same.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SUPERSEDING RULE 4, SHEET NO.1

- 4. If a meter is removed by request of the customer, and the customer subsequently requests that the meter be replaced, in the same location, within twelve months of the time it was removed, then a charge of \$11.00 may be made. Such charge will include the cost of removing the meter.

Also, when the service has been disconnected for nonpayment of bills or for violation of the District's rules and regulations, a charge of \$11.00 will be made to reconnect the service, which charge shall include the cost of disconnecting the service.
