On November 29, 1995, Milford Water Company ("Milford"), owner and operator of a water distribution system in southern Madison County, Kentucky, filed a petition seeking the Public Service Commission's approval of the transfer of ownership and control of its water distribution system to Richmond Water, Gas, and Sewerage Works ("RWGS"). The terms of the proposed transfer were set forth in a Contract of Sale entered into by both parties, a copy of which was attached to the application. The Contract of Sale was executed on behalf of Milford by Lucy A. Martin, President of Milford, as authorized by the unanimous consent of the Board of Directors and the Shareholders of Milford by a joint resolution duly adopted by the Directors and Shareholders at a special meeting on September 26, 1995, and on behalf of RWGS by Ann L. Durham, Mayor of the City of Richmond, as approved and directed by City of Richmond Ordinance No. 95-49, adopted and enacted by the City Commission for the City of Richmond on November 21, 1995, a copy of which was attached to the application.





Service Charge - A charge of \$10.00 shall be charged for all service turn ons.

Meter Reading Recheck - A charge of \$10.00 shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to be rechecked for a correct reading and the meter was not misread.

Returned Check charge - There will be a \$10.00 charge on all customer checks returned to the Company non-paid.

Delinquent Service Charge - There will be a \$15.00 charge to reconnect a meter which has been disconnected due to the customer's non-payment of bill. (This fee includes the expenses incurred in disconnecting the delinquent account)

Meter Installation - There will be a \$425.00 charge for all meter installations.

Meter Drop - There will be a \$65.00 charge for all meter drops. A meter drop is when a new meter is placed into a meter vault installed by a developer. (Only those places where no service has ever existed fall into this category.)

I. Service Classification. There shall be no distinction of this category.

II. Service Application.

A. The Water Company may reject any application by a customer when the applicant is delinquent in payment of bills for service previously supplied at any location.

B. Violation of any of the provisions of these rules, by-laws, or any other regulations of the Water Company, and the Water Company may remove the meter and discontinue service in accordance with procedures described in 807 KAR 5:006 (11). Where the meter is thereafter reinstalled, the customer shall first pay to the Water Company a reinstallation charge of \$15.00. Customers receiving service as a part of an extension of service are required to contract for service for one year. Such customers shall contract for service according to the rates in effect or the minimum monthly rate, which ever is greater, whether or not the customer uses the service. The Water Company may require deposit of 2/12 of annual bill.

C. The individual in whose name the customer certificate is prepared shall be responsible for all bills incurred. Customers shall be responsible for their own bills. Customers shall pay the applicable deposit before the meter is turned on.

III. Initial or Minimum Charges

A. The flat, monthly rate, as set up in the water rate schedule for the year will be payable irrespective of whether any water is used by the customer during any month. Customer shall not be charged for any month where service has been discontinued.

B. In the event the Water Company may be required to remove the meter for non-payment of bills, the Water Company when service is again restored, will make a charge for such reinstallation of \$15.00.

C. Water furnished for a given lot or farmstead shall be used on that lot only. Each customer's service must be separately metered at a single delivery and metering point. All commercial use, .

IV. Water Company Responsibility

A. The Water Company will install, maintain and operate a main distribution pipeline of lines from the source of water supply and service lines from the main distribution line of lines to the property line of each customer of the Water Company at which point, designated as delivery points, meters to be purchased, installed, owned and maintained by the Water Company shall be placed. The costs of the service line or lines from the main distribution line of lines of the Water Company to the property line of each customer shall be paid by the Water Company. The Water Company will also purchase and install a cut-off valve to be owned and maintained by the Water Company and to be installed on the same portion of the service line owned by the Water Company. C. Under normal conditions, the customers will be notified of any anticipated interruption of service.

B. If the Water Company is called upon to provide additional meters, each place of metering will be considered as a separate and individual account.

C. The customer shall provide a place of metering, which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.

D. The customer shall furnish and maintain a private cut-off valve on the customer's side of the meter. The company is to provide a like valve for the Water Company's side of such meter.

VII. Extensions to Mains and Services.

A. The Water Company will supply service for temporary purposes, provided that the company has water available in excess of its regular needs, and provided the company has available material and equipment necessary to supply said service.

VIII. Access to Premises

A. Duly authorized agents of the Water Company shall have access, at all reasonable hours, to the premises of the customer for the purpose of installing or removing Water Company property, inspecting piping, reading or testing meters or for any other purpose in connection with the company's service and facilities.

B. Each customer shall grant or convey, or shall cause to be granted or conveyed to the Water Company a permanent easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said permanent easement and right-of-way is necessary for the company water facilities and lines, so as to be able to furnish service to the customer.

IX. Change of Occupancy

A. Not less than one weeks notice must be given in person or in writing to the Water Company to discontinue service or to change occupancy.

B. The outgoing party shall be responsible for all water consumed up to the time designated for discontinuance of service.

C. A charge of Ten(\$10.00) Dollars will be made for each meter for each turn-on.

B. Bills for water will be figured in accordance with the Water Company's published rate schedule and will be based on the amount consumed for the period covered by the meter reading.

C Charge for service commences when the meter is installed and connection made, whether used or not.

D. Reading from different meters will not be combined for billing irrespective of the fact that said meters may be for the same or different premises, or the same or different services.

E. Bills are due when rendered and become delinquent fifteen(15) days after due date.

F. D. The Water Company reserves the right to discontinue its service for the following reasons:

1. Without notice, for customer's fraudulent or illegal use of service.
2. For customer's non-payment of bills. However, the company shall first make all reasonable effort to induce customer to pay the bill, and thereafter, customer shall be given at least 48 hours written notice, mailed to his last known address. In no event shall service be cut off before the 20th day after the date on which the original bill was mailed to the customer. In the event customer submits a written certificate of a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer to the company stating that discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the effective premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make living arrangements, or until 10 days lapse from the date of the company's written notice whichever occurs first. In case of conflict between the Water Company's prescribed procedures for discontinuance of service and the procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:006 (11) of the Public Service Commission Regulations, 807 KAR5:006 (11) shall govern.

XII. Complaints-Adjustments

A. If the customer believes his bill to be in error, he shall present his claim, in person or in writing to the Water Company before the bill becomes delinquent. Such claim, if made after the bill has become delinquent, shall not be effective in preventing discontinuance of service, heretofore provided. The customer may pay such bill under a protest and said payment shall not prejudice his claim.

B. The Water Company will make special meter readings at the request of the customer for a fee of Ten (10.00), provided, however, that if such special reading discloses that the meter was overread, no charge will be made.

C. Meters will be tested at the request of the customer, for a fee of fifteen (15.00) provided, however if test discloses that the meter was in error, no charge will be made. No charge will be made if the meter has not been tested within the test-interval period prescribed by 807 KAR 5:006 (17).

D. If the seal of a meter is broken by other than a Water Company representative or if the meter fails to register correctly or is stopped for any cause, the customer shall pay an amount estimated from the record of the previous bills and/or from other proper data.

DEPOSITS

The Company may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills except for customers qualifying for service reconnection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, Winter Hardship Reconnection. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The Company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer. EFFECTIVE

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

1. Previous payment history with the Company. If the customer has no previous history with the Company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
2. Whether the customer has an established income or Grade of Credit.
3. Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area.
4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.
5. Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.
6. Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or 10 percent for a non-residential customer, the Company may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

1 Water districts should substitute KRS 74.050 and water associations should substitute KRS 273.392 since these statutes govern the rate of interest to be paid by water districts and associations.

MONITORING OF CUSTOMER USAGE

At least once annually the Company will monitor the usage of each customer according to the following procedure:

1. The customer's annual usage for the most recent 12-month period will be compared with the annual usage for the 12 months immediately preceding that period.
2. If the annual usage for the two periods are substantially the same or if any difference is known to be attributed to unique circumstances, such as unusual weather conditions, common to all customers, no further review will be done.
3. If the annual usages differ by percent or more and cannot be attributed to a readily identified common cause, the Company will compare the customer's monthly usage records for the 12-month period with the monthly usage for the same months of the preceding year.
4. If the cause for the usage deviation cannot be determined from analysis of the customer's meter reading and billing records, the Company will contact the customer by telephone or in writing to determine whether there have been changes such as different number of household members or work staff, additional different appliances, changes in business volume, or known leakage in the customer's service line.
5. Where the deviation is not otherwise explained, the Company will test the customer's meter to determine whether it shows average error greater than 2 percent fast or slow.
6. The Company will notify the customers of the investigation, findings, and any refunds or backbilling in accordance with KAR 5:006, Section 10(4) and (5).

In addition to the annual monitoring, the Company will immediately investigate usage deviations brought to its attention as a result of on-going meter reading or billing processes or customer complaints.
