RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Where an adequate water distribution main is not available to the property for which customer has requested service, the District will install 50 feet of main at no cost to customer with remaining costs to be paid by customer in advance of construction plus the applicable connection fee.
2. A customer requesting water service to rental property shall place a deposit of \$20.00 with the District. Said deposit shall be refunded at such time as customer discontinues his service less any unpaid accounts.
3. Multiple residence units (including mobile homes) served through a single meter connection shall be billed under the established rate schedule for the number of residence units served. (Total metered consumption divided by number of residence units = number gallons each unit to be billed for.)
4. The minimum monthly billing for new commercial trailer courts shall be the equivalent of four single residence units with 5/8 inch meter.
5. Water service is to be discontinued when billings are 60 days delinquent. A reconnection charge of \$10.00 plus the delinquent account must be paid to reinstate service.
6. The customer shall not sell or give away water.
7. The customer requesting a connection for fire protection service shall pay the published connection fee and monthly rate for same.
8. Water service installations on customers property shall comply with the Kentucky State Plumbing Code.
9. The District will install mains in subdivisions for developers, provided estimated cost of mains is paid for in advance by developer. For each rate paying customer connected to such main or mains, the District will refund the developer the cost of 50 feet of said main installation. Refunds will be made in January of each year, the total of all refunds shall not exceed original cost of main installation, the time limit on refund contract shall not exceed 10 years and no interest is to be paid on any monies or deposits made for this purpose.
10. Installation of pressure reducing valves in areas of high water pressure shall be at the customer's expense.
11. Water meters are the property of the Water District and shall be maintained by the District.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

This schedule of Rules and Regulations governs the furnishing of water service by PULASKI COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 1 hereinafter referred to as the Utility and applies to all service received from the Utility. No employee or individual director of the Utility is permitted to make an exception to Rates, Rules or Regulations. All Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations. The Utility is further subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Commission even though not contained herein.

REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

SERVICE AREA

The Utility furnishes water service to Central Portion of Pulaski County located at Science Hill, Kentucky in Pulaski County, Kentucky.

AVAILABILITY

Water service is available to any domestic, commercial or industrial consumer within the Utility's area.

WATER FAILURE

The Utility is responsible for water failure only when in control of the Utility's employees. No consumer is paid damages for equipment unless such damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of ~~Public Service Commission~~ the part of the Utility or its employees.

PROTECTION BY CONSUMER

Consumer shall protect the equipment of the Utility on his premises and shall not interfere with Utility's property or permit interference except by duly authorized representatives of the Utility.

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

MAINTENANCE

The Utility may at any time deemed necessary, suspend sewer service to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of its system. The Utility shall give reasonable notice of such suspension of service to the consumer.

The Utility shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Utility and the consumer shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion thereof installed by the consumer.

EXTENSION OF SERVICE

Extension of service shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066E, Section 12.

LINE RELOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate facilities, the cost will be paid by party or parties requesting such relocation.

BILLING, COLLECTION, PENALTIES

Bills for water service furnished by the water system will be mailed no later than the ? 5th day of each month and will be due and payable within ? 10 days (or by the ? 1st day of the following month). A 10 % late payment penalty charge will be applicable after the due date of any account.

DEPOSITS

The Utility may require from any customer or applicant for service a cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant where bills are rendered monthly, or three-twelfths (3/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered bimonthly, or four-twelfths (4/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered quarterly. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum will be paid on deposits so required, accruing from the date of deposit.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice, for failure to comply with its rules and regulations or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for fraudulent or illegal use of service, or for nonpayment of bills. If discontinuance is for non-payment of bills, the customer shall be given at least forty-eight (48) hours written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effected not less than twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may not be effected until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until not less than ten (10) days elapse from the date of the Utility's notification. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service shall be cut off without notice or refused.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**FIRE HYDRANTS**

The fire hydrants installed on the distribution lines of this District are for the primary purpose of flushing the lines, or other uses by the District necessary for proper maintenance of the lines, and the secondary purpose is to assist fire protection units in the performance of their duties. The District is not responsible for, nor does it guarantee, any minimum pressure at these hydrants, other than the minimum pressure required by the Public Service Commission for distribution lines. Any damage to the distribution lines, resulting from excessive pumping pressure applied by any fire fighting unit will be the liability of that unit.

**PAYMENT OF WATER BILLS**

All customer water bills or tap on fees will be paid to the Science Hill office of First & Farmers Bank of Somerset, Kentucky during regular business hours.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

NEW EXTENSION POLICY

The District shall determine the total cost of the proposed water main extension (exclusive of meter connections) and the total length of the extension. The District shall pay that portion of the cost of the water main extension equal to 50 feet for each applicant for service. That part of the cost not covered by the District's portion shall be contributed equally by those applicants desiring service on the main extension. Each applicant will also be required to pay the District's approved "Tap-on-Fee" for a meter connection to the main extension.

For a period of five years after the original extension construction of the main extension each additional customer directly connected to each particular extension will be required to contribute to the cost of that water main extension based on the recomputation of both the District's portion of the total cost and each customer's contribution as set out above. The District must refund to those customers that have previously contributed to the cost of each main extension itself that amount necessary to reduce their contribution to the currently calculated amount for each customer connected to that extension. All customers directly connected to each main extension for a five-year period after it is placed in service are to contribute equally to the cost of the construction of the water main extension itself. In addition each customer must pay the approved "Tap-on-Fee" applicable at the time of their application for the meter connection. The "Tap-on-Fee" is not a part of the refundable cost of the extension and may be changed during the refund period. After the five-year refund period expires, any additional customer applying for service on each main extension must be connected for the amount of the approved "Tap-on-Fee" only. Also, after the five-year refund period expires, the District will be required to make refunds on an additional five-year period in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066 Section 9(6).
