RULES AND REGULATIONS

SECTION 1. WATER CONNECTION CHARGES.

Water connection charges are hereby established and shall be exacted for each connection with the waterworks system of the District, based on the respective dates on which application is or was filed and on the respective sizes of meter connections, as follows:

<u>SIZE OF METER CONNECTION</u>		<u>CONNECTION OR TAP-ON FEE</u>
5/8" x 3/4" Meter	FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY - No. 1 Billing (Single Family Unit)	\$250.00 Each
5/8" x 3/4" Meter	FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY - No. 2 Billing (Multiple Family Unit)	\$250.00 Each
3/4" x 3/4" Meter	For Commercial Property	\$300.00 Each
1" Meter	For Commercial Property	\$350.00 Each
2" Meter	For School and Factory	\$650.00 Each

SECTION 2. RIGHTS ON PAYMENT OF WATER CONNECTION CHARGES.

Water connections shall be made available to the owners of any premises (including residential, commercial, or industrial) abutting upon any street, road, alley, public way or easement in which a water line is constructed by the District within 50 feet of the property line or easement of such owner. Such lines shall be considered available to any premises as to which the boundary line or easement is located within 50 feet of such water line.

Any and all property owners to whom such lines are so available shall be entitled to a water connection upon timely payment of the prescribed water connection charge as set out above.

Any and all owners of properties where the property line or easement is located more than 50 feet from a water line shall be entitled to the same privilege by paying the additional cost of bringing a water line the additional distance, in excess of 50 feet, to his property line or easement.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SECTION 10. TERMINATION ON REQUEST.

The Management of the District waterworks system shall terminate water service to any customer within twenty-four (24) hours after receipt of written request from such customer to terminate such service.

SECTION 11. DEPOSITS.

A deposit approximately equal to two times the average monthly bill may be required of any customer before service is supplied if the Management of the District waterworks system deems it necessary to insure payment for the service it will render. Upon termination of service, deposit may be applied against unpaid bills of the customer, and, if any balance remains after such application is made, said balance to be refunded to the customer.

Interest will accrue at the rate of 6% per annum on any deposit. Upon termination of service any accumulated interest will be applied against unpaid bills of the customer, and if any balance remains after such application is made, said balance will be paid to the customer.

The District will issue, to every customer from whom a deposit is received, a certificate of deposit showing the name of the customer, location of initial premises occupied, date and amount of the deposit.

SECTION 12. OWNERS PAY CONNECTION CHARGES; OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS JOINTLY LIABLE FOR MONTHLY RATES.

Connection charges, where applicable, shall be the personal obligation of the owners of the respective properties. All water charges, other than connection charges, shall be the personal obligation, jointly and individually collectible by law, of the owner and the occupant of the lot, property or building receiving the benefits of such use and service so long as the same continues, and the satisfaction of the liability by any party shall be a discharge of the liability for which the payment is made.

SECTION 13. MULTIPLE USERS.

Where two or more tenants or occupants (of different rental units) of property are served by a single water meter, the water rates and charges shall be the personal obligation, collectible by law, of the person or persons who apply for such service and, make the required deposit.
