RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Residential and commercial service shall consist of a 3/4 inch off 3 inch connection to the districts main, a 3/4 inch service line and a meter setter enclosed on a concrete or clay box with a metal cover. Services of a larger size may be installed of the customers expected water use will justify such installation.

2. Meters will be installed in the service at the customers request provided the required deposit and service installation costs (if any) have been made or terms of payment have been agreed to.

3. Service and installations to a location where no service line has previously been installed will be paid for at actual cost by the customer. This cost will consist of labor and materials as determined by the water superintendent. Estimates of the costs will be furnished to the customer prior to installation, but the amount so estimated is subject to adjustment based upon costs actually incurred by the district. No cost will be incurred by the district until the customer has entered into a contract whereby he accepts the obligation to pay such costs.

4. Main extentions will be considered of their individual merit. The district will not pay for any main extentions beyond 50 feet for a single customer. Costs beyond 50 feet will be paid by the customer or customers. Costs for service lines are in addition to main extentions.

5. Customers will be billed for service at the rate currently in effect for the district on or about the first of each month based on meter readings obtained during the previous month. Such bills shall be on a form which clearly shows the present and previous meter registrations of the customers meter, the gallons of water consumed, and the amount of service charge, the amount of Kentucky Sales Tax, and use tax, any penalties then due, and the total amount to be paid.

6. Customer billings not paid on or before the 10th day of each month shall be subject to the addition to a 10% penalty charge. Customer billings not paid within 15 days thereafter shall be subject to a 10% penalty charge of the meter and discontinuance of waterservice.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are applicable to all water service rendered by Southside Water Association, Inc.

1. Residential and commercial service shall consist of a 3/4 inch or 3 inch connection to the District's main, a 3/4 inch service line and a meter setter enclosed in a concrete or clay box with a metal cover. Services of a larger size may be installed if the customer's expected water use will justify such installation.
2. Meters will be installed in the service at the customer's request provided the required deposit has been made and service installations costs (if any) have been made or terms of payment have been agreed to.
3. Service and installations to a location where no service line has previously been made will be paid for at actual cost by the customer (or property owner). This cost will consist of labor and materials as determined by the water superintendent. Estimates of cost will be furnished the customer prior to making the installation but the amount so estimated is subject to adjustment based on costs actually incurred by the District. No cost will be incurred by the District until the customer has entered into a contract whereby he accepts the obligation to pay such costs.
4. Main extensions will be considered on their individual merits but the District will not pay for any main extension beyond 50 feet for a single customer. Costs for extensions beyond 50 feet will be paid by the customer or customers. Costs of service lines are in addition to main extension costs.
5. Customers will be billed for service at the water rate currently in effect for the District on or about the first of each month based on meter readings obtained during the previous month. Such bills shall be on a form which clearly shows the present and previous registrations of the customer's meter, the gallons consumed and the amount of service charge. The bill shall show the amount of Kentucky Sales Tax and Use Tax, any penalties then due and the total amount of billing to be paid.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

7. Meters, meter boxes, covers, valves, and fire hydrants as well a all other facilities of the Water Districts Plant and Distribution System are classified as private property under Kentuvky Law. Anyone tampering with a meter or damagfing any unit of the Districts property shall be subject ot prosecution under the Law. All costs incurred by the district in making repairs to or replacement of such damaged property shall be paid by the offender.

8. The District assumes no responsibilty for payment of water bills to a person not authorized to recieve such payment by the District.

9. Each district meter is to serve only one residence, one commercial buuilding, or other structure which cannot be classified as a multiunit water consumer.

10. Extention of customer service lines from any point on the customers side of a meter or delivery of water in any manor to a location other than to the customer in whose name the meter is registered shall be considered a violation of the Districts Operating Rules.

11. The customer or property owner whose name in which the meter is registered shall be responsible for payment of the amount of water consumed each month. Rental property owners you as owner are responsible for payment of the total amount of water consumed each month for your property.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

6. Customer bills not paid on or before the 10th of each month shall be subject to the addition of a 10 percent penalty. Customer bills not paid within 15 days thereafter shall be cause for removal of the meter and discontinuance of water service.

7. A charge of \$20.00 shall be made for reinstallation of a meter after it has been removed for either non-payment of a customer bill or at the customer's request.

8. Meters, meter boxes and covers, valves and fire hydrants as well as all other facilities of the Water District's plant and distribution system are classed as private property under Kentucky Law. Anyone tampering with a meter or damaging any unit of District property shall be subject to prosecution under the law and all costs incurred by the District in making repair to or replacement of such damaged property shall be paid by the offender.

9. The District assumes no responsibility for payment of water bills to a person or persons not authorized to receive such payments by the District.

10. Each District meter is to serve only one residence, one commercial building or other structure which cannot be classified as a multiunit water consumer. A multiunit water consumer is any location served where there are two or more residential apartments, two or more businesses in the same building, or where there is any combination of residence and business in the same building. Each residence or business shall be considered a separate customer. Extension of customer service lines from any point on the customer's side of meter or delivery of water in any manner to a location other than to the customer in whose name the meter is registered shall be considered a violation of the District's operating rules. The customer whose name the meter is registered shall be responsible for the payment of the total bill.

The foregoing rules and regulations shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after June 1, 1993 and will remain in effect until such time a written amendments thereto are published.

CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICE

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DEPOSITS

The Company may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills except for customers qualifying for service reconnection pursuant to 807 KAR 5:006, Section 15, Winter Hardship Reconnection. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and required deposits will be returned after one (1) year if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The Company may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

In determining whether a deposit will be required or waived, the following criteria will be considered:

1. Previous payment history with the Company. If the customer has no previous history with the Company, statements from other utilities, banks, etc. may be presented by the customer as evidence of good credit.
2. Whether the customer has an established income or line of credit.
3. Length of time the customer has resided or been located in the area.
4. Whether the customer owns property in the area.
5. Whether the customer has filed bankruptcy proceedings within the last seven years.
6. Whether another customer with a good payment history is willing to sign as a guarantor for an amount equal to the required deposit.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account differs from the recalculated amount by more than \$10.00 for a residential customer or 10 percent for a non-residential customer, the Company may collect any underpayment and shall refund any overpayment by check or credit to the customer's bill. No refund will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent at the time of the recalculation.

1. Water districts should substitute KRS 74.050 and water associations should substitute KRS 273.392 since these statutes govern the rate of interest to be paid by water districts and associations.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. DEPOSIT: \$50

"Interest will be paid on all sums held on deposit at the rate of 6 percent annually. The interest will be applied as a credit to the customer's bill or will be paid to the customer on an annual basis. If the deposit is refunded or credited to the customer's bill prior to the deposit anniversary date, interest will be paid or credited to the customer's bill on a pro-rated basis. If interest is not credited to the customer's bill or paid to the customer annually, interest will be computed by a method which will result in an amount no less than that obtained by using a middle course method between simple and compound interest in compliance with Commission Order dated October 31, 1989 in Case No. 89-057. Interest on deposits computed in this manner will accrue until credited to the customer's bill or paid to the customer."
