Deposits: The Utility may require from any customer or applicant for service a cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant where bills are rendered monthly, or three-twelfths (3/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered bimonthly, or four-twelfths (4/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered quarterly. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum will be paid on deposits so required accruing from the date of deposit.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are intended to supplement all bond resolutions and by-laws which have been enacted by the District, and which are incorporated by reference.

1. All bills must be paid by the 10th day of each month, and said bills will be paid only by check or money order, and mailed to P. O. Box 536, Maysville, Kentucky 41056/ All bills not paid by the 10th day of the month following its receipt shall incur a 10% penalty. For bills not paid timely a notice will be mailed on the 11th day of that month directing that payment shall be made by the 15th day of that month. For any account not paid after receipt of the aforementioned notice a second notice shall be mailed advising the customer that their service will be discontinued within 48 hours if the account, including penalty, has not been paid.
2. Should it become necessary to discontinue any service there shall be a reconnection charge of \$15.00. The reconnection charge and the delinquent bill must be paid in full at the District Office at 217 Court Street, Maysville, Kentucky, between 9:00 A. M. and 4:30 P.M., Monday thru Friday. Payment cannot be made at any other location or to anyone other than the District's bookkeeper.
3. Should any customer have any complaint those complaints must be directed to the District Office at 217 Court Street, Maysville, Kentucky, or by calling 564-9333.
4. There will be a service charge of \$7.00 for all returned checks.
5. Before any new connection can be made the customer must come to the District Office, sign a contract, and pay the connection fee. There will be no exceptions to this rule. For anyone desiring to extend lines this must be brought before the Commission at the monthly meeting at 7:30 P.M., the second Tuesday of each month at the District Office.
6. Should any customer have a water leak and immediately repair said leak when it has been discovered the District will make a water leak adjustment. No more than three leak adjustments can be made in any one year.
7. Should it become necessary for the District to relocate water lines or to install the lines to a deeper depth because of excavation done by the customer,

the cost of relocating said lines shall be paid for by the customer. Should any water meter have to be raised or lowered because of any excavation then that cost shall likewise be paid by the customer.

8. The Washington Lewisburg Water District is supervised by a Board of Commissioners. These Commissioners meet monthly at 7:30 P.M. on the second Tuesday of each month. Customers are encouraged to meet with the Commission should they have any problems.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are intended to supplement all bond resolutions and by-laws which have been enacted by the district, and which are incorporated by reference.

1. Meters will be read monthly between the 15th and 24th of each month.

2. Bills will be dated and mailed on the 1st of each month. Said bills will state that they are to be paid within 15 days. However, provisions contained in the rate resolution as to penalties; cut-offs and meter deposits will apply, and district may terminate service for failure to pay water bill.

3. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission from district on the property to be served.

4. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and his decisions may be appealed to the district commission within 10 days.

5. The principal place of business of the district will be District Office, Washington, Kentucky

6. Water bills may be paid at District Office, Washington, Ky.

7. In addition to standard connection fees, the district can require any developer of more than 1 lot (subdivider) or potential large user to furnish storage or pumping facilities or to enlarge supply lines or to guarantee payment of a minimum bill over a period of years by special contract.

8. The customer cannot give away or resell water without the written consent of the district.

9. Each house must be metered separately, unless the written consent of the district to do otherwise is obtained.

10. Regulatory provisions of the rate resolutions, bylaws, if any, and bond ordinances are made a part of this rate resolution, together with standard customer contract and subdivision contract provisions.

11. No residence shall be served through a field connection, if field connections are authorized by the rate tariff.

12. The district does not guarantee either pressure or flow on any fire hydrant nor the working condition of any such fire hydrant. The hydrant is installed merely as a convenience for the purpose of serving as a reloading station for fire fighting equipment. No one shall use any fire hydrant for any purpose other than fire fighting use.

13. The district will permit main line extensions, storage and pumps paid for by customer, when in the judgment of the district's engineer there is sufficient pressure and volume for such extensions. Refunding agreements based on a refund of a portion of water bills and/or connection fees in excess of meter and installation costs over a period of 10 years can be established to pay up to all extension costs advanced by the customer including district administrative and professional charges by billed the customer.
