RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
 2. Any resident of WEST DAVIESS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT is eligible for water service from the District provided said resident does not require a special line to be laid in order to accomodate the resident.
 3. Water service will be terminated within 24 hours after receiving a written request from the customer requesting the discontinuance.
 4. All applications for service, where meter is already existing on property, will be accompanied by a deposit of \$5.00 if the customer is the owner-tenant of the premises and by a deposit of \$10.00 if the customer is a tenant-resident of the premises, refundable at the termination of service after all outstanding bills are paid.
 5. The point of delivery of water is the point where the meter is located on the customer's premises. All water lines, plumbing and equipment beyond the meter shall be maintained by the customer.
 6. All meters, service connections and other equipment shall be and remain the property of the District. Customers shall provide a space for, and exercise proper care to protect the property of the district on its premises, and in the event of loss or damage to the District's property arising from the neglect of the customer to care for same, the costs of necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer.
 7. Meters will be read and bills rendered monthly.
 8. Ten days will be allowed for payment of bill. After due date (due date shown on billing card) 10 percent penalty will be added to the bill.
 9. After due date, and upon five days written notice, water service will be discontinued for non-payment of water service bill.
- *(a) After service is discontinued, the customer shall pay his delinquent account, plus a service charge of \$5.00 to disconnect, and in the case of a reconnect an additional charge of \$5.00 for said reconnection.





RULES AND REGULATIONS

Minimum Charges:

Shall be \$4.50 for which 2,000 gallons or less of water may be used.

Delayed Payment Charge:

Ten days will be allowed for payment of bill. After due date (due date shown on billing card) 10 percent penalty will be added to the bill.

Reconnection charge:

A disconnection charge in the amount of \$5.00 will be made to disconnect a meter which has been disconnected for non-payment of bill or for violation of these rules and regulations, an additional charge of \$5.00 shall be made for reconnection.


Such charge shall provide for a tap at the water main and a service line run to the property line of the customer and a meter installation at that point.

16. When a prospective customer desires to extend a line to his own property, off the established main as originally constructed and approved, the customer will pay the District the additional construction costs for said extension, or in the alternative construct it himself according to specifications of District; the newly constructed extended line becomes the property of the District when completed; any new taps after completion of the extended line along said extended line will be \$250.00 as aforesaid, but \$100.00 of said tap fee will be reimbursed to the customer who paid for the construction costs of said extended line; District reserves the right to hook on to the newly extended line and extend it further at any time.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 17. Where a customer's property is not contiguous to the main water line right of way, as in the case of being down a lane therefrom, customer has the responsibility of constructing his own line from the meter, said meter to be situated either 30 feet from the center line of the road right of way or on the water line right of way at the option of the customer.
