Re: Merger of SBC Internet Services, LLC into AT&T Corp.

Dear Executive Director:

Consistent with prior Orders of the Commission,<sup>1</sup> this letter is to notify the Kentucky Public Service Commission that on or about May 31, 2016, SBC Internet Services, LLC (“SBC Internet”) will be merged into AT&T Corp. in an internal corporate reorganization. SBC Internet has no Kentucky customers. Following the transaction, AT&T Corp. will be the surviving entity. This is entirely an internal corporate reorganization, and it will have no impact on customers’ rates, terms, or conditions of service.

AT&T Corp. is authorized by the Commission to operate as a CLEC and an IXC. AT&T Corp.’s principal place of business is located at One AT&T Way, Bedminster, New Jersey 07921. AT&T Corp. is organized under the laws of the state of New York and is a wholly owned subsidiary of AT&T Inc.

SBC Internet is an administrative affiliate organized under the laws of the state of California. SBC Internet’s principal place of business is located at 2623 Camino Ramon, San Ramon, California 94583-9130. SBC Internet is a wholly owned subsidiary of AT&T Inc. and has no Kentucky customers of its own. This transaction will be effective on May 31, 2016.


The transaction is part of an internal reorganization intended to simplify the corporate structures within the AT&T family of companies. The transaction will be seamless to customers. There will be no change in the ultimate ownership of the merged companies, which will remain with AT&T Inc. Moreover, the reorganization will have no impact on customers’ rates, terms, or conditions of service.
