Dear Ms. Smith:


Kentucky Hearing and Telephone Corporation (“Kentucky Hearing”), Brooks Rule (“Transferor”), and Glenda Sue Harvison (“Transferee”) (collectively, “the Parties”), through the undersigned counsel and pursuant to the Order No. 370 issued in Admin. Case No. 359 on January 9, 1998, hereby provide an informational notice to the Commission regarding a transaction whereby ownership and control of Kentucky Hearing will be transferred to a new owner. Under the terms of this transaction, 100 percent ownership of the stock of Kentucky Hearing will be transferred from Transferor to Transferee.

This change in ownership of Kentucky Hearing’s stock does not involve a transfer of operating authority, assets or customers, and the transaction is expected to be seamless to any end user customers. Following consummation of the transaction, Kentucky Hearing will continue to offer the same services, rates, terms and conditions pursuant to its existing authorization. Any current customers of Kentucky Hearing will remain customers of Kentucky Hearing. Accordingly, the transaction will be imperceptible to Kentucky customers, who will continue to enjoy the same rates, terms and conditions of service as they do prior to closing. Because Kentucky Hearing will continue its corporate existence and current operations,

including existing tariffs, no tariff adoption notice under 807 KAR 5:011, Section 11, is being provided with this notice.
