Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

The purpose of this letter is to request that the Commission cancel the Certificate of Authorization of ACC National Long Distance Corp. (ACC). ACC is an indirect subsidiary of AT&T Corp. (AT&T). ACC presently is authorized to sell long distance telecommunications and operator services in Kentucky with certificate numbers 512880 and 22251288. ACC currently has no customers and has ceased providing these telecommunications services.

The request to discontinue ACC's authorization and to cancel its tariffs will have no impact on any Kentucky consumers. All services formerly provided by ACC are now being offered or will be offered by other AT&T entities. This request is being made as part of an internal AT&T program to streamline corporate operations and reduce the number of AT&T Corp. affiliates and subsidiaries.

Accordingly, by this letter, ACC respectfully requests that ACC's Certificate of Authorization and its accompanying intrastate tariffs be cancelled.
