# SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, LLC D/B/A AT&T SOUTHEAST

AT&T Services, Inc., on behalf of its affiliate, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Southeast ("AT&T"), applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended ("the Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.71, to discontinue BellSouth Managed Shared Ring service throughout its service territory in Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.

As required by Section 63.71(a) and (b) of the Commission's rules, AT&T provides the following information:

### Name and Address of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(l), (b)(2)):

## Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(2), (b)(2)):

AT&T plans to discontinue offering this service on or after November 20, 2015, pending regulatory approval.

## Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

AT&T will no longer offer this service in Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.

#### Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

BellSouth Managed Shared Ring service is a managed high capacity shared network service capable of providing a transport link with high performance and reliability parameters and a level of redundancy/diversity designed to limit a single event from interrupting service. AT&T is discontinuing this service because there is no customer demand.

# Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. §63.71(b)(3)):

AT&T has no customers that subscribe to this service. Copies of this Application are being sent, first class U.S. Mail, to the public utilities commission and governor of each state in which discontinuance is proposed and also to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.<sup>1</sup>

#### Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

AT&T offers this service pursuant to dominant carrier regulation via the Bellsouth Telecommunications Tariff FCC No. 1, Section 6, Access Service.
