Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the Commission's Wireline Broadband Order, ¹ Cincinnati Bell Inc., on behalf of its affiliated local exchange carriers, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC and Cincinnati Bell Extended Territories LLC, hereby notifies the Commission that beginning May 1, 2007, Cincinnati Bell will no longer offer its ZoomTown DSL service as a common carrier service. This change affects all geographic areas served by CBT and CBET. Cincinnati Bell intends to offer alternative arrangements to customers on a non-common carrier basis as permitted by the Order.

As required by the Order, Cincinnati Bell notified affected customers via First Class U.S. Mail on or before April 1, 2007 that beginning May 1, 2007, Cincinnati Bell would no longer offer ZoomTown ADSL and ZoomTown Direct ADSL service on a common carrier basis. Attached is a copy of the notice provided to customers.

A copy of this letter is being submitted to the state public utility commission and the Governor of each the three states in which Cincinnati Bell will discontinue its common carriage offering of ZoomTown DSL service. A copy is also being provided to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Department of Defense.

Notice of Deregulation of Cincinnati Bell ZoomTown® DSL Service Effective May 1, 2007

Under the provisions of the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order (FCC 05-150 effective November 16, 2005), Cincinnati Bell is no longer required to offer DSL service as a regulated telecommunications service under Title II of the Communications Act.

This letter is to advise you that effective May 1, 2007 Cincinnati Bell will begin offering ZoomTown DSL service as a non-regulated service subject to the terms and conditions posted on our website at: http://www.cincinnatibell.com/customer_support/policies/zoomtown/

Cincinnati Bell ZoomTown DSL services include the following:

- Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line (ADSL) simultaneously carries voice signals and high-speed digital data signals to enable consumers to access the Internet over their existing copper lines.
- Direct ADSL ADSL service provisioned to accommodate a static Internet Protocol (IP) address. Additional static IP addresses can be provided by the ISP.

There will be no changes to your ZoomTown DSL service and no changes to the ZoomTown DSL monthly rates, however, details and charges will be moved to a different part of your telephone bill. Your continued use of your ZoomTown DSL service after May 1, 2007 will constitute your consent to the terms and conditions outlined on our website. These terms and conditions are similar to those under our existing offering and will apply to your ZoomTown DSL service until you make any change affecting the line over which the service is provided.

This change affects all ZoomTown DSL Affiliated ISP customers throughout the Cincinnati Bell Telephone and Cincinnati Bell Extended Territories serving areas.
