Re: Notice of Acquisition of Additional License to Provide Commercial Wireless Service and of Plans by East Kentucky Network, LLC to expand its Commercial Wireless Service Offering into Letcher, Harlan and Bell Counties, Kentucky

Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (the "Commission") of the acquisition of an additional license (the "Transaction") by East Kentucky Network, LLC ("Appalachian Wireless") which provides Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") authorization for the provision of Broadband Personal Communications Service ("PCS") in the Middlesboro--Harlan, KY Basic Trading Area.

It is our understanding that Kentucky law does not require Commission approval of the Transaction and we provide this notice consistent with the Commission's Order in Administrative Case Nos. 359 and 370, issued August 8, 2000.

- The Transaction involved a partitioning of the Frequency Block A PCS license held by Triton PCS License Company L.L.C., such that Appalachian Wireless received a license to operate on 20 MHz of PCS spectrum in the Middlesboro--Harlan, KY Basic Trading Area, comprised of four counties: Bell County, KY; Harlan County, KY; Letcher County, KY; and Claiborne County, TN.
- The Transaction was strictly a cash transaction with the assignor. Appalachian
  Wireless did not incur any indebtedness, not did it grant any entity a security interest
  in any asset acquired as a part of the Transaction.
- Appalachian Wireless currently provides cellular service in markets defined by the FCC as Kentucky Rural Service Areas 9 and 10. That service offering is to be expanded into three additional Kentucky counties as the result of the Transaction, which was consummated January 12, 2006. Appalachian Wireless has not constructed any facilities in the three additional Kentucky counties as of yet but plans to expand service in those areas this year as soon as facilities are in place. The additional service area will benefit both customers and prospective customers of the company.
