Re: *ICG Telecom Group, Inc. – Surrender of CPCNs*


Dear Ms. Stumbo:

In 1995 and 1996, the Commission issued certificates of public convenience and necessity (“CPCNs” – See Case Nos. 94-516 and 96-501) to ICG Telecom Group, Inc. (“ICG”) to provide local exchange and intrastate interexchange services in Kentucky.<sup>1</sup> In 2006, Level 3 Communications acquired ICG.

ICG does not provide in the Commonwealth of Kentucky any telecommunications or other services, own or control any facilities or have any customers. Accordingly, ICG desires to surrender its CPCNs. ICG requests that the Commission take such action as may be necessary to accomplish surrender of its CPCNs.
