WorldCom, Inc. is in receipt of three letters dated May 3, 2002 concerning filing of gross operating revenues for Intermedia Communications, Inc. (long distance utility), MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC (long distance utility) and WorldCom Network Services, Inc. (long distance utility). Intermedia Communications, Inc. reported total intrastate revenue on the Report of Gross Operating Revenues filed March 29, 2002. At this time no breakout of local and long distance revenues is available. In addition, MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC reported intrastate revenues on March 29, 2002. At this time MCImetro has no long distance revenues in the state of Kentucky. Attached you will find copies of both of the gross revenue reports for Intermedia and MCImetro for reference.

WorldCom Network Services, Inc. was merged into MCI Telecommunications

Corporation in September of 1999. As a result of this merger, the certificate for WorldCom

Network Services, Inc. was cancelled. Please remove this company from your active list.

On March 29, 2002, WorldCom, Inc. submitted their 2001 Reports of Gross Operating Revenue for the subsidiaries certificated in the State of Kentucky. At that time, WorldCom's Annual Report to Shareholders / Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission was unavailable.
