RE: Notice of consummation of merger between Sprint Corporation and T-Mobile US, Inc.

Dear Mr. Chandler:

Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint Communications") is authorized by the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Kentucky as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier ("CLEC") and interexchange carrier ("IXC").¹ Sprint Communications is an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Sprint Corporation ("Sprint").

Pursuant to the Commission's Order in Administrative Case No. 370², Sprint Communications hereby provides the Commission notice that, on April 1, 2020, a transaction was completed by which Sprint merged into an indirect subsidiary of T-Mobile US, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), with Sprint surviving as an indirect subsidiary of T-Mobile and by which Sprint Communications became an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of T-Mobile (the "Indirect CLEC Acquisition"). Because the Indirect CLEC Acquisition occurred by virtue of a transaction at the parent holding company level only, there was no change in the operating authority held by Sprint Communications.
