U.S. South Communications, Inc. d/b/a U.S. South and d/b/a INCOMM ("U.S. South") and First Data Corporation ("First Data") are pleased to announce that through a merger transaction, U.S. South will be joining the First Data family of companies and become an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of First Data. The target date for this merger is as early as June 30, 2008.
