This letter is filed on behalf of Vanco Direct USA, LLC ("Vanco") which is presently authorized to provide resold interexchange and local services in this State. The purpose of the letter is to inform the Commission of a transaction whereby Barclays Bank PLC, The Royal Bank of Scotland Plc and Lloyds TSB Bank Plc will collectively make available to Vanco, Vanco's parent company (Vanco plc) and certain of its affiliates, the sum of 92 million pounds Sterling (approximately \$170,000,000.00) which will be secured by the guarantee of Vanco, a security interest in Vanco's assets and a pledge of Vanco's membership interests.
