Please accept this letter as a formal request by Verizon Business<sup>1</sup> that the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") cancel the tariff of its subsidiary, MCI Network Services, Inc. ("MCINS"). This request is part of an effort by Verizon Business to streamline its business operations in a manner that will simplify administrative requirements for the company, regulators and customers.

Specifically, Verizon Business requests cancellation of MCINS' tariff. MCINS has no customers and provides no telecommunications services. MCINS' filed a letter on February 2, 2006 requesting that its registration be cancelled.

On Jan. 6, 2006, MCI, Inc. merged into MCI, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Verizon Communications Inc. Verizon Business operating units provide enhanced services and local, long-distance, and other telecommunications services domestically and internationally.
