Re: Section 63.71 Application of Verizon Long Distance and Verizon Enterprise Solutions

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, Verizon Long Distance ("VLD") and Verizon Enterprise Solutions ("VES"), both located at 1320 North Courthouse Road, Arlington, Virginia 22201, provide notice that they are discontinuing an audio call conferencing service called "Conference Connections Service." This service will be discontinued on July 13, 2007. Written notice was sent to affected customers via U.S. Mail on May 17, 2007. A copy of the customer notice letter is attached to this letter. VLD and VES are considered non-dominant with regard to the service being discontinued.

Verizon Conference Connections provides voice conferencing capabilities and features that link calls onto a single, interconnected bridge. It includes reservation-less conferencing capabilities. Customers are billed for Verizon Conference Connections only when they use it. There are no recurring charges; customers simply activate call conferencing capability.

Dear Customer:

As you know, as a result of their recent merger, Verizon and MCI are continuing to integrate their services and products. As part of that integration, Verizon Long Distance and Verizon Enterprise Solutions (collectively, "Verizon"), both located at 1320 N Courthouse Road, Arlington, Virginia, 22201, will file an application with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") under Section 63.71 of the FCC rules for approval to discontinue an existing service. Specifically, Verizon is seeking approval from the FCC to withdraw its audio conferencing service, referred to as "Conference Connections Service," effective July 13, 2007.

Verizon's Conference Connections Service provides voice conferencing capabilities and features that link calls onto a single, interconnected bridge. The service includes reservation-less conferencing capabilities and is further described on Verizon's posted rate and service schedule on Verizon's public website. Verizon's Conference Connections Service is provided throughout the country.

Although not bound to do so, you may migrate your service to the Audio Conference service offered by Verizon Business. Other providers may offer audio conferencing services, and you are free to choose one of them. Whatever choice you make, it is the goal of Verizon to make this transition as smooth as possible for you and your business operations.

The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service (or reduction or impairment) unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. Address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, D.C. 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the Section 63.71 Application of Verizon Long Distance and Verizon Enterprise Solutions. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance (or reduction or impairment) upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire a reasonable substitute service.
