COMMISSION STAFF REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO CLARK ENERGY COOPERATIVE, INC.'S FILING FOR COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE RESOURCES FOR ENERGY SAVINGS PROGRAM

- 1. In the November 26, 2019 Order in Case No. 2019-00060, the Commission found that Clark Energy should "take steps to initiate and engage in conversations with their local CAAs and encourage them to participate in this low-income residential program".
 - a. Explain the steps Clark Energy took between the issuance of the November 26th Order and the filing of the proposed CARES tariff.

Response: In order to be responsive to the Commission's request, Clark Energy believed they should seek and acquire approval for the Community Assistance Resources for Energy Savings (CARES) program tariff before approaching the local Community Action Agencies (CAAs) serving our area. Therefore, we have not had any discussions with the CAAs since the November 26th Order.
