
RATE DCP
(Data Center Power)

I. Applicability

Rate DCP is available in all territory served.

II. Availability

This tariff is available to any retail customer that owns or operates or proposes to own or operate an eligible Data Center as defined in EKPC's Tariff, Rate DCP P.S.C. No.35, Original Sheet No. 103, Section III.

III. Contract

Before any retail customer may take service under this tariff, the customer must engage in contract negotiations with the distribution cooperative and EKPC. The contract must contain all necessary and proper provisions pursuant to EKPC's Tariff, Rate DCP, P.S.C. No. 35, Original Sheet No. 103, Section IV, Section V, Section VI, and Section VII and comply with EKPC's Tariff Rate DCP, P.S.C No. 35, Section VIII.

The contract will contain the rates, which shall be revised from time to time as determined by the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC"). The initial rate will be the effective date of the contract and will include any additional rates that are applicable or available for such electric service under any other applicable riders and tariffs; which may include: Fuel Adjustment Charge, Rate ES – Environmental Surcharge; Rate D – Interruptible Power; Rate H – Wholesale Power Energy Program; and Power Factor Adjustment.

The terms and conditions of the contract must be approved by the PSC before any retail customer may take service pursuant to this tariff.

IV. Deviations

With Kentucky Public Service Commission approval, EKPC and Cumberland Valley Electric may deviate from the terms of this Tariff for good cause which shall be determined by EKPC and Cumberland Valley Electric in their sole discretion.
