The purpose of the Access Services Tariff filing is to update certain terms and conditions to reflect service discontinuance in the service area affected by the copper retirement affecting Turkey Creek Road and US 25E. The Cumberland River flooded and took down utility poles and cable across the river in the area of Fourmile, KY. This area is identified in AT&T Kentucky's records as distribution area 4203PA in the Pineville wire center (PIVLKYMA) which serves the Pineville exchange. AT&T is restoring many services in this area with a fiber-to-the-premises network architecture, which will increase the broadband service options for this area.
