Attached for filing with the Commission are tariff pages that revise AT&T Kentucky's ("AT&T") Access Services Tariff. The revised pages will become effective on August 2, 2019.

Access Services Tariff, Section E2 – Sixth Revised Page 3

This filing is being made in conjunction with the FCC's Second Report and Order in WC Docket No. 17-84 (FCC 18-74) released June 8, 2018 (Zero Demand Forbearance). The language being added to AT&T Kentucky's tariff by this filing provides that AT&T Kentucky is no longer required to offer certain services in geographic areas where there are no customers subscribing to those services. To be clear, no existing customers are affected by this filing, nor are any areas affected in which AT&T Kentucky is already providing services to existing customers. The only change occasioned by this tariff filing is that, in the event a potential customer requests one of the affected intrastate services in an area where AT&T Kentucky is not already providing the service and has no existing customers, AT&T Kentucky may decline the request for service.
