Re: Power Purchase and Interconnection Agreement (From a Qualifying Facility with a Design Capacity Under 100kW) with Gallrein Farms Shelby County, LLC

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Please find enclosed for filing with the Commission, via the electronic tariff filing system, the above-referenced special contract.

This agreement is between Gallrein Farms Shelby County, LLC (“Seller”), Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc., (“Shelby Energy”), and East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”). The Seller owns a Qualifying Facility (“QF”), as defined by 807 KAR 5:054, Section 1 (8), and desires to produce electric energy for both its own use and to sell to EKPC through Shelby Energy’s system. EKPC desires to purchase such energy from the Seller. Seller has chosen not to receive capacity payments.

The Seller shall reimburse EKPC for any incurred interconnection costs, estimated at \$0.00. Any energy purchased by EKPC from Seller shall be purchased in accordance with the tariffs, rules and regulations established by EKPC and approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission for qualifying Cogeneration and small power production facilities.

While this special contract indicates the effective date is April 26, 2024, the parties acknowledge that the contract will not become effective until the Commission either

accepts or approves the agreement. Thus, the initial five-year term of the contract will not start until the receipt of the Commission's acceptance or approval.
