Whereas, KY PSC has previously approved a water leak adjustment for Bracken County Water District ("BCWD"), wherein the current policy only allows one leak adjustment per eighteen (18) month period, and the board realizing that many customers do not realize the leak until the second billing period due to the billing period cycles, and believes it is fairer to the customers to modify the leak adjustment period to allow two consecutive billing periods to have leak adjustments pursuant to the policy, if KY PSC would allow the modification to the leak adjustment policy.

BCWD desirous of having a modification to the current leak adjustment policy to allow two (2) consecutive leak adjustment policies during an eighteen (18) month period, and Board of Commissioner Eddie Kern made amotion to modify the current leak adjustment policy to allow two (2) consecutive leak adjustment policies during an eighteen (18) month period, and seconded by Rich King, and said resolution was approved by majority vote, and it is HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


