

UNDERSTANDING YOUR BILL.....

- ♦ Failure to receive your bill does not excuse penalty or payment.
- ♦ Unpaid bills will result in water service shut off. A reconnect fee plus the total amount due must be paid to restore service.
- ♦ If you are moving, please contact our office to avoid continuing charges.
- ♦ High Usage? Check for leaks first.

CHECK FOR LEAKS

Check all toilets and faucets. Leaky toilets and faucets are the biggest cause of wasted water resulting in large bills. The most common source of leaks is the toilet. Check toilets for leaks by placing a few drops of food coloring in the tank. If after 15 minutes the dye shows up in the bowl, the toilet has a leak. Leaking toilets can usually be repaired inexpensively. Toilets can account for almost 30% of all indoor use, more than any other fixture or appliance.

A continuous leak from a hole this size at an average household water pressure of 60 psi would, over a month period, result in the water usage listed above.


