

## LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that Carroll County Water District (“District”) plans to file with the Public Service Commission on or before November 8, 2019 to adjust its rate structure for 1inch meters and larger. The proposed effective date is January 1, 2020. The proposed changes are as follows:

### 5/8 x 3/4 Meter Tap

First	1,000 gallons	No Change
Next	4,000 gallons	No Change
Next	5,000 gallons	No Change
Next	30,000 gallons	No Change
All over	40,000 gallons	No Change

### 1 Inch Meter Tap

First	5,000 gallons	\$43.50 minimum bill
Next	5,000 gallons	8.00 per 1,000 gallons
Next	30,000 gallons	5.00 per 1,000 gallons
All over	40,000 gallons	2.80 per 1,000 gallons

### 2 Inch Meter Tap

First	15,000 gallons	\$108.50 minimum bill
Next	25,000 gallons	5.00 per 1,000 gallons
All over	40,000 gallons	2.80 per 1,000 gallons

### 3 Inch Meter Tap

First	30,000 gallons	\$183.50 minimum bill
Next	10,000 gallons	5.00 per 1,000 gallons
All over	40,000 gallons	2.80 per 1,000 gallons

### 4 Inch Meter Tap

First	50,000 gallons	\$261.50 minimum bill
All over	50,000 gallons	2.80 per 1,000 gallons

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the District, but the PSC may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any person may submit a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing
