RE: Formal Application for Revision of Non-recurring Charge

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

This application is to revise certain non-recurring charges for Corinth Water District. Attached are the meeting minutes, legal notice, cost justification forms and supporting documentation.


This filing is not part of a general rate case. The District can no longer absorb increased costs attributable to certain non-recurring charges. The customers affected by this increase will be the customers that cause the District to incur these additional costs. The Board of Commissioners approved the non-recurring charges at the December 4, 2025, regular meeting. The new charges will take effect for services rendered after February 15, 2026.

Corinth Water District's income statement and balance sheet is on file with the Public Service Commission. The proposed rate revisions do not exceed by 5% the total revenues provided by all non-recurring charges for a recent period of twelve consecutive calendar months ending within 90 days of submitting the tariff filing.

The District has published the enclosed public notice in Grant County News on February 15, 2025. An affidavit from the newspaper verifying that the notice ran for three consecutive weeks will be forwarded to the Commission.
