Re: Inter-County Energy - 2022 DSM Program Changes

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Please find enclosed for filing with the Commission Inter-County Energy's revised tariffs for the following Demand Side Management ("DSM") Programs:

- DSM-Button-up Weatherization Program
- DSM CARES (Community Assistance Resources for Energy Savings Program)

Supporting the East Kentucky Power Cooperative ("EKPC") DSM tariff filing on April 22nd, 2022, Inter-County Energy has worked with EKPC, to re-evaluate the cost-effectiveness and need for all existing DSM programs. The conclusions of this re-evaluation were to recommend two changes to Inter-County Energy's existing portfolio of DSM programs. The two changes are summarized as follows:

- The Community Assistance Resources for Energy Savings Program ("CARES") will no longer be restricted to only Community Action Agencies. The proposed revision will allow other 501(c)(3) organizations with affordable housing missions to participate in the program
- The Button-Up Weatherization Program revision will add a stand-alone measure for sealing HVAC ducts in homes that heat with electricity.

Enclosed in this filing are copies of the modified DSM Program tariffs for each of the DSM programs listed above. The tariffs are tendered in a format showing the strike-throughs of the existing tariffs for convenience.

This institution is an equal opportunity provider and employer.

Pursuant to KRS 278.180(1), Inter-County Energy must give at least 30-days' advance notice to the Commission of any proposed changes in its rates. Therefore, the proposed effective date of these tariff revisions will be July 15, 2022. Because the DSM tariffs are voluntary in nature and do not affect the amount that a customer pays for service or the quality, delivery, or rendering of a customer's service, public notice pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8 is not required. Nevertheless, Inter-County Energy has posted a notice at its office located at 1009 Hustonville Road, Danville, KY 40422, and will post the requisite notice on its website as well as post it on social media outlets, no later than five (5) business days from today's date, which will include a hyperlink to the Commission's website where the tariff can be found.
