

## CUSTOMER NOTICE

On or about February 1, 2024, the Oldham County Water District (“District”) will file with the Kentucky Public Service Commission revisions to its Tariff governing the charges associated with establishing a new metered water service connection (“Meter Connection/ Tap-On Charges”). These charges have not been revised since 2009. If approved and not suspended, the revised Tariff will become effective on March 4, 2024. The proposed Tariff revisions will not affect any current customer’s monthly bill. The District’s substantive revisions to the Tariff include, but are not limited to, those outlined below.

**Rock Removal.** The cost of Meter Connection does not include rock removal. Rock removal will be performed at actual cost to be paid by the Customer to the District, in addition to the Meter Connection/ Tap-On Charge.

If the Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication of this Notice, the Commission may take final action on the Tariff filing.
