NOTICE

Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos Energy” or “the Company”) hereby gives notice pursuant to the requirements of the Kentucky Public Service Commission as set forth in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8 (“PSC” or “Commission”) that it will propose new rates for customers previously supplied by Millennium Energy on or before September 1, 2026. Atmos Energy will request that the new tariff and the new rates associated with the new tariff become effective on or after October 1, 2026.

The present and proposed rates are contained in the Table below. The present rate is the current rate approved and on file with the Commission for Millennium Energy and the proposed rate is the current rate approved and on file with the Commission for Atmos Energy. The Table also shows the increase or decrease in both dollar amount and percent for each customer class.

* The Tables above do not include gas cost (GCA) adjustment amounts or Riders. Atmos Energy's current GCA is \$5.5595/Mcf. Millennium's current GCA is \$2.9823/Mcf. Atmos Energy has the following Riders that apply to all Residential bills: PRP Rider rate of \$0.4817/Mcf and a R&D Rider rate of \$0.0174/Mcf. Atmos Energy has the following Riders that apply to all Commercial bills: PRP Rider rate of \$0.6796/Mcf and a R&D Rider rate of \$0.0174/Mcf.

Atmos Energy is not proposing revisions to its tariffs other than to align the Millennium customers to the appropriate Atmos Energy rate schedule and non-recurring charges.

If the Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of initial publication or mailing of this notice, the Commission may take final action on the tariff filing. The new tariff contained in this notice is the tariff and rates proposed by Atmos Energy, but the Commission may order rates or changes to the tariff that differ from the proposed rates and the tariff contained in this notice.
