Mr. Croissant,

While reviewing the tariff filing submitted by Atmos on October 31, 2019, Staff came up with a couple of questions. Please see below.

1. Refer to tab DLSA and the final Order in Case No. 2018-00281, page 52. Explain why the lost sales were not reset to zero on May 8, 2019.

I will set the lost sales for May through August to 0 and re-submit. (Do I submit this via email or the website?)

2. Refer to tab DSMRC Costs. Explain why there are promotional and miscellaneous costs included for February 2019 for the residential and commercial rebate programs.

The rebates were processed in the appropriate time frame, but did not make it through the reporting process until February.

3. Refer to tab DSMRC Recoveries & Sales. Explain why commercial sales for September 2018 through December 2018 are negative.

Commercial volumes were not actually negative, it is just a peculiarity in how the system shows volumes when the rate is negative.

The calculations on the other sheets take this into account.
