RE: Proposed Water Rate Increase

Dear Mr. *Spalding*:

The Campbellsville Water & Sewer Committee met on March 25, 2025 and voted to recommend to the Campbellsville City Council an increase in Marion County Water District's rate for water service from Campbellsville Water.

The Wholesale Water Rate for Marion County Water District will increase from \$3.48 per 1000 gallons to \$3.59 per 1,000 gallons.

The Campbellsville City Council had the first reading of the proposed rate increase on Monday, June 16, 2025, and the anticipated second reading on Monday, July 21, 2025.

The proposed rate increase will be effective for water used on and after August 1, 2025.
