## MUNICIPAL ORDER OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETHTOWN, KENTUCKY APPROVING AN AGREEMENT HARDIN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT #2

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of Elizabethtown, Kentucky, held on the date set out below, a Motion to read and adopt the following Municipal Order was duly made, seconded and approved:

Whereas, the City of Elizabethtown owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant known as the Valley Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant, which is ideally located and has adequate reserve capacity to treat the wastewater generated in the Glendale area of southern Hardin County; and,

Whereas, the Hardin County Water District No. 2 has commenced construction of the Nolin River Watershed Wastewater Project which will provide wastewater collection service in the Glendale area of southern Hardin County; and,

Whereas, the Elizabethtown City Council approved by Municipal Order #51-2013 an agreement with Hardin County Water District No. 2 for a Sewer Wholesale Rate for the treatment of wastewater for the Glendale area; and.

Whereas, the CITY and HCWD#2 wish now to further define the terms and conditions of that Agreement to provide the most cost efficient and environmentally sound manner for wastewater treatment.

BE IT ORDERED, that the City of Elizabethtown approves the Wastewater Treatment Agreement with the Hardin County Water District #2 for the wastewater treatment of the Glendale area at the Valley Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant as detailed on Exhibit A. BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Mayor of the City of Elizabethtown and/or her designate be and she is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to perfect this Order.
