Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on August 2, 2024, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Kentucky) for the six months that ended on October 31, 2023. As part of this review, Duke Kentucky responded to two requests for information.

A review of Duke Kentucky's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six months under review ranged from a low of \$0.032340 per kWh in May 2023 to a high of \$0.036518 per kWh in October 2023 with a six-month average of \$0.034397 per kWh.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of Duke Kentucky's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges and credits billed by Duke Kentucky through its FAC from May 1, 2023, through October 31, 2023, are approved.

2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
